In this series of foraging wild things, we have covered a variety of wild plants that grow here in western Kentucky.

Some of the plants we are covering are edible, some are medicinal but, most are both.

Please research and positively identify any plants before using them.

Remember, do not use plants that may have been exposed to chemicals and again, do your research.

Pine Tree

The needles of most species of pine trees have both edible and medicinal properties. They have antibacterial and pain relieving properties.

White Pine are the best to use and the easiest to identify with five needles to each bundle.

Back in the days when people experienced winter starvation, the natives would eat the barks to fend off hunger by cutting off a piece of soft white inner bark.

Pine trees are a good source of vitamins



needles have more vitamin C than lemons or oranges.

It makes an excellent tea and infusion for sore throat and headache. It can also help cough, bronchitis, and other chest congestions. You may also extract the sap from the inner bark for treatment of diarrhea, scurvy, and wound cleaning.

Most Pinus species are edible and the best part is that they have antiviral compounds. During the 1918 flu epidemic, Native Americans in the Pacific NW were treating scurvy with pine needles and found that those patients did not catch the flu.

A decoction from white pine tar helps treat tapeworm infestation and also for treating dandruff.

White pine has five needles in each cluster, the size of each needle is 3 to 5 inches long. In starting, it is bluegreen, later it becomes dark green and drops in the fall.

White pine cones are 3-6 inches long. It originates from the end of the pine's branches.

Other pines can be used and in our area one is the Yellow Pine, which has 3 needles to a cluster.

DO NOT USE pine in large amounts or while pregnant or nursing. As with many medicinal things, it can be harmful when overused and can be harmful to infants under 1 year.

Pine Needle Cough Syrup

First, bring the water to a boil then pour it over the pine needles in a pint mason jar.

For a stronger pine needle flavor you can boil the pine needles in the water for a few minutes before taking off the heat. Just be aware that this does diminish some of the vitamin C content.

Let the infusion steep until the water has cooled to room temperature, then strain out the pine needles and stir in the honey.

Store the syrup in a covered jar in the refrigerator and it will keep for 2-4 weeks. If you'd like to increase the shelf life of this syrup, freeze it in baggies or ice cube trays and then thaw as needed before use.

Take one tablespoon every two hours as needed to ease a cough, relieve chest congestion, or to soothe a dry and scratchy throat.

Pine Resin Infused Oil

To make a pine resin infused oil, break up/ crush any hardened pieces of sap and place in a jar with any softer bits you may have. Pour your chosen fixed oil (olive, grape seed, almond...) over the resin. A ratio of 1:2 (resin weight: oil volume) will make a thick extraction. A 1:5 ratio will make an extract that is easier

to work with and still

very potent.

Let the mixture sit for about 3 weeks in a warm spot, like near a wood stove. One may also choose to heat the mixture in a double boiler or crockpot for 6-8 hours for a quicker extraction. Strain and

Have a double boiler or crockpot that is specific for heating resins, as it will get sticky over time.

Add melted beeswax to the infused oil to make an easy to apply healing salve. Depending on your desired consistency of the salve, a good rule of thumb for how much beeswax to add is. 1 ounce of beeswax to 8 ounces of infused pine

Poisonous barks and pine needles that should be avoided are the:

 Norfolk Island Pine (Araucaria heterophylla)

• Yew (Taxus) Remember pine trees are different than spruce, fir, hemlock,cedar and junipers.

As always positively identify before using any wild plants.
