Now comes Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Energy Kentucky or the Company) pursuant to the Kentucky Public Service Commission's (Commission) June 30, 2026 order in the above-captioned proceeding and submits the following short list of issues for discussion at the August 11, 2026 informal conference:

1. Developing separate guidelines for interconnection and net metering, in recognition of the fact that not all interconnectors are net metering customers;
2. Developing distinct guidance regarding the interconnection of prospective applicants with capacity of more than 45kW;
3. Providing for cost recovery for utilities for any changes required to be made to systems as a result of updates made to the guidelines; and
4. Updating amounts for application fees, including Level 1 Applications.

Duke Energy Kentucky looks forward to participating in the upcoming informal conference and to continuing the discussion as needed throughout this case.
