Comes now the Kentucky Solar Industries Association, Inc. ("KYSEIA"), by and through counsel, and, in response to the Commission's June 30, 2026 Order in the instant case, tenders its list of topics for discussion at the scheduled informal conference. The list below is general in nature to identify topics.

1. Improvement in interconnection policy by eliminating inconsistent practices among Kentucky jurisdictional utilities concerning interconnection applications, review, and action by the utility upon review – including the need for stage-by-stage improvement in notification of the receipt of documents by the utility and the issuance of documentation/communication (including the decision of the utility) by the utility; clearly defined path for interconnection (with timelines and expedited review paths); clear formal identification of deficiencies (through written documentation) and steps to correct deficiencies; and improvements in applications for interconnection

service by new customers, permission to operate, and temporary power shutoffs;

2. Whether and, if applicable, when a stamped engineering drawing is required;
3. Energy storage resources and the need for guidance and uniformity in the review of storage resources and devices for controlling export battery storage;
4. AC Rating of Grid-Interactive Inverters;
5. Emerging technologies and guidelines for review;
6. Improving transparency of grid capacity and improved communication and documentation of infrastructure capacities in response to applications;
7. Improvements in utility dispute resolution practices and policies;
8. IEEE 1547-2018 and other industry guidance standards for updating interconnection practices in Kentucky; and
9. Meter Collars.

WHEREFORE, KYSEIA tenders its List of Topics.
