**KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY AND
LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS**

Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) (collectively, the “Companies”) respectfully offer the following supplemental comments in response to the Commission’s Orders dated February 4, 2026, and March 12, 2026, in this proceeding.

First, the Companies continue to support the positions and arguments advanced in their April 19, 2021 Brief in this proceeding. As the Companies stated therein, the current Net Metering Guidelines (“Guidelines”) remain highly relevant and serviceable, which is a testament to the hard work done by the Commission and all parties to Administrative Case 2008-00169. At most, a few revisions, not a wholesale rewriting, are all the Guidelines require; the Companies’ recommended revisions are set forth in their April 19, 2021 Brief. Also, the Companies continue not to have current or anticipated issues or concerns regarding Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Order No. 2222.

Second, if the Commission desires to revise the Guidelines, the Companies respectfully recommend that the Commission amend the procedural schedule in this case to follow a notice-and-comment approach. For example, after receiving this round of comments and responsive comments by April 20, 2026, the Commission could issue proposed revisions to the Guidelines for

review and provide an opportunity for written comments by the parties. Such an approach would allow the parties to provide additional constructive input and should help ensure that any revisions to the Guidelines better meet the needs of customers and the utilities that serve them.
