As required in the PSC Order for Case No. 2020-00331, please be advised that the construction began on January 11, 2020. The 50 percent completion mark was reached around April 1, 2021. We apologize for not notifying the Commission as ordered at the start of construction and at the 50 percent mark. It was an oversight on our part.

Construction is not yet complete; the District requested that the existing 10-inch water line that was taken out of service remain on the bridge for at least a year to reassure that the new 12-inch water main that was installed along the Fishing Creek Bridge was secure and leak free. An inspection is to take place within the next month and if all is secure and leak free, the process of removing the existing 10-inch will take place to complete the project.
