MOTION TO SUBMIT REPORTS OUT OF TIME

Hyden-Leslie County Water District ("Hyden-Leslie District") moves the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for leave to submit its monthly surcharge reports for the months of December 2020 and January 2021 out of time. In support of its Motion, Hyden-Leslie District states:

1. On November 6, 2020, the Commission issued an Order in Case No. 2020-00141¹ in which it authorized Hyden-Leslie District to assess a monthly surcharge of \$1.53 per customer for 48 months, or until \$263,124 has been assessed, whichever occurs first, to fund its unaccounted-for water loss reduction efforts. It further required Hyden-Leslie District to file monthly with the Commission an activity report that includes a statement of monthly surcharge billings and collections; a monthly surcharge bank statement; a list of each payment from the account, its payee, and a description of the purpose; and invoices supporting each payment. These reports were to be filed in this docket

2. Hyden-Leslie District began issuing customer bills on which the monthly surcharge appeared in the month of December 2020.

3. Hyden-Leslie District has yet to submit the required reports for December 2020 and January 2021. No report was submitted in December 2020 because of the limited information to report and the payment period for that December bills had not yet concluded. Billing software problems that resulted in incorrect billings to several customers in January 2021 prevented a timely submission of the report for January 2021. These problems have been corrected.

4. Hyden-Leslie District apologizes to the Commission for its failure to submit these reports in a timely manner and requests the Commission's permission to submit these reports no later than February 15, 2021 with its February 2021 monthly surcharge activity report.

5. Hyden-Leslie District represents that in the future it will timely comply with all provisions of the Commission's Orders of November 6, 2020 in this proceeding and in Case No. 2020-00141.

WHEREFORE, Hyden-Leslie County Water District requests an Order permitting it to file its monthly surcharge activity reports for the months of December 2020 and January 2020 with the Commission no later than February 15, 2021.
