
**POST-HEARING BRIEF

FEDERAL EXECUTIVE AGENCIES**

The United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies respectfully requests that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approve the Stipulation and Recommendation on the basis that the settlement is fair, just, and reasonable. Kentucky Utilities Company, Louisville Gas & Electric Company, and the intervenors, who represent varied and diverse customer interests, engaged in a multiday, good faith settlement negotiations that resulted in a unanimous Stipulation and Recommendation. The Stipulation and Recommendation contained transparent terms, which allowed the Commission to independently assess them. On

April 24-26, 2021, the Commission held its evidentiary hearing on the cases where it thoroughly and carefully assessed the terms of the unanimous Stipulations and Recommendation.

WHEREFORE, the United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies respectfully requests that the Commission approve the unanimous Stipulation and Recommendation.


