The United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies ("DoD-FEA") respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission for an Order granting DoD-FEA an excusal from the August 17-18, 2021 hearing on the reasonableness of the Tariffs Net Metering Service-1, Net Metering Service-2, Small Capacity Cogeneration Qualifying Facilities, and Large Capacity Cogeneration Qualifying Facilities proposed by Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company.
