**RESPONSE OF JOINT INTERVENORS IN SUPPORT OF KENTUCKY SOLAR
INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION, INC. MOTION FOR AMENDMENT OF PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

Come now Joint Intervenors Kentucky Solar Energy Society, Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Mountain Association (in Case No. 2020-00349) and Metropolitan Housing Coalition (in Case No. 2020-00350) (collectively “Joint Intervenors”) and for their response in support of the motion of the Kentucky Solar Industries Association, Inc. (KYSEIA), to amend the procedural schedule established by the Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) June 30, 2021 Orders in each of the above-styled cases, states as follows.

Joint Intervenors believe that KYSEIA’s participation through the testimony and data request responses of its expert witnesses, has materially contributed to the full exploration of the

issues associated with both net metering service and qualifying facilities in the instant cases. Since the request to adjust the procedural schedule seeks only a slight adjustment, to which neither LG&E and KU nor any other party have indicated opposition, and since the schedules of KYSEIA's expert witnesses Benjamin Inskip and Justin Barnes demonstrate good cause for such adjustment, Joint Intervenors support the requested adjustment to the procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, Joint Intervenors support the request of KYSEIA to amend the schedule of procedure in the above-styled cases, and respectfully request that the Commission approve the request and adjust the procedural schedule as requested.
