

LG&E and KU have worked diligently to finalize their analysis, but their efforts have not yet been concluded due to significant workload and schedule constraints.

**WHEREFORE**, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting an extension of time to file their RTO Membership Analysis.
