JOINT STATUS REPORT

Inter Mountain Cable, Inc. and BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Kentucky, by counsel, hereby file their Joint Status Report and state as follows.

Following the filing of InterMountain Cable's Unopposed Motion to Continue All Deadlines, the parties reached a mutual resolution of their dispute related to the Interconnection Agreement. The parties continue the process of taking all steps necessary to accomplish the resolution that was agreed upon to resolve the outstanding issues related to the disputed interpretation of the Interconnection Agreement. The parties agree that there is one action remaining to accomplish the mutual resolution, at which point the parties agree all known disputes will have been resolved. As a result, the parties believe that this matter will be resolved without the need for further intervention from the Commission, and request an additional forty-five (45) days to complete the single remaining action necessary to finalize the parties' mutual resolution.
