NOTICE OF FILING

Comes now Henderson County Solar LLC (“Applicant” or “Henderson Solar”), by and through counsel, and hereby provides notice to the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (“Siting Board” or “Board”) of filing its three-month status update as directed by the Board in its April 30, 2026 Order (“Order”).

The Order contained supplemental mitigation measures applicable to Henderson Solar’s merchant electric generating facility (“Project”), including Mitigation Measure No. 2, which provides as follows:

Henderson County Solar shall submit a status report to the Siting Board every three months from the date of this Order until the project begins generating electricity to update the Siting Board on the progress of the Project. The report shall reference this case number and be filed in post-case correspondence in this case. The report shall include a summary of complaints and construction progress as well as any issues with financing or compliance with any other mitigation measures.

Public feedback includes the following summary of complaints: concerns related to Project layout, component locations, and property boundaries with respect to individual residences; impacts to community resources, including prime farmland and natural areas; construction scheduling and related delays; adequacy of existing mitigation measures, including the characteristics of vegetative screening and location of the pollinator habitat; concerns regarding

ownership transparency and the ownership transfer process; frustration with local government decisions; cumulative noise and pollutant emissions from the Project and existing nearby sources; concerns regarding coordination with local emergency responders; and the distribution of public meeting notices and Siting Board orders concerning the Project.

With respect to construction progress, engineering designs have been advanced to the construction-ready stage. The Applicant's construction team mobilized to the Project site on June 15, 2026, including civil construction, survey, and logistics teams. Site activities since mobilization have been limited pending issuance of remaining required permits. Construction-related activities include receipt of construction materials and equipment, mowing, and surveying. Issued land disturbance permits from state and county authorities are active and in compliance.

To date, there are no issues to report related to Project financing.
