PETITION OF NAVITAS KY NG, LLC FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

COMES NOW Navitas KY NG, LLC ("Navitas") by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby submits its Petition for Confidential Treatment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, and KRS 61.878, requesting the Commission to grant confidential treatment to certain sensitive financial information provided in the Journal Entries in this filing. In support of this Petition, Navitas states as follows:

Notification of Information at Issue

1. The Confidential Information in "Journal Entries" includes the private financial data on page 1 in the 6th column, rows 2, 4-7, 10 and 11 and the 7th column, rows, 1, 3, 8-11; on page 2, in the 2nd column, rows 4-17, in the 3rd column, rows 4-17, in the 4th column, rows 4-17, in the 5th column, rows 4-17, and the 6th column, row 15; on page three, for the far right column, rows, 4, 10-12, 19-21, and the second column from the right, rows 2, 5-8, and 14-17.

Confidential or Proprietary Commercial Information

- 2. The Kentucky Open Records Act exempts from disclosure certain commercial information. To qualify for the exemption and maintain the confidentiality of the information, a party must establish that the material is of a kind "generally recognized as confidential or proprietary, which if openly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to competitors of the entity that disclosed the records." The Commission has routinely relied on this section of the Kentucky Records Act to grant confidential protection to third-party documents when disclosure would disadvantage the Company.
- 3. The Confidential Information found in "Journal Entries", consists of private work product regarding the acquisition of the systems and consists of sensitive financial information material to the Parties. This information "if openly disclosed would present an unfair commercial advantage to competitors" of Navitas and it therefore qualifies as protectable confidential information pursuant to KRS 61.878(1)(c)(1).
- 4. This Confidential Information is not publicly available. It would be difficult or impossible for someone to discover this information from other sources. The disclosure of this proprietary information would result in significant or irreparable competitive harm to Navitas KY NG, and its parent company, Navitas Assets, by providing its competitors with non-reciprocal competitive advantage. No public purpose is served by the disclosure of such Confidential Information.
