RE: Order Clarification with GCA Filing

Dear Ms. Jankowski:

Navitas is formally seeking clarification in part of the April 27, 2021 Final Order in Case No. 2020-00396. Navitas is concerned to have received conflicting information as to interpretation of the reference Order in relation to the tariff and in particular to the GCA portion.

The two conflicting issues are as follows: One interpretation of the Order is that all Actual and Balance Adjustments were to be dropped then restarted fresh with the past balance somehow incorporated. The second interpretation is that the existing and previously approved Actual Adjustments and Balance Adjustments are to continue until they run their normal twelve-month course.

Our understanding is there has been some discussion between yourself and our GCA counsel, Allyson Honaker on this matter.

As I've previously expressed I feel that it is imperative that we do this correctly as there is a substantial amount of under collected gas costs outstanding such that it has a meaningful impact on the health of Navitas KY NG, LLC.

As time is of the essence in this matter, Navitas have taken the step of submitting the tariff associated with the alternative interpretation of this matter along with this letter.
