In Kentucky, the more than \$58 million of RDOF funding assigned to TWCIS will help enable Charter to expand the availability of its network and services in the RDOF Census Blocks. As a demonstration of Charter's commitment to bridging the digital divide in these unserved areas, in addition to the RDOF funding, Charter plans to invest more than \$100 million of its own capital to construct a high capacity low latency network to offer these services in the RDOF Census Blocks in Kentucky. Together Charter's investment and the RDOF funding will result in delivering advanced broadband and voice capabilities to a significant number of unserved households and small businesses in the Commonwealth.
