
**RESPONSE TO ORDER ANNOUNCING INTENT
TO INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE THE RECORD
OF OTHER COMMISSION PROCEEDINGS**

Ohio County Water District (“Ohio District”) does not object to the incorporation by reference of the record of Case No. 2020-00167 into the record of this proceeding.

Ohio District requests that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) also incorporate by reference the records of Cases No. 2001-010 and No. 2005-00425 in the record of this proceeding as well as the record of TFS 2005-02023. In Case No. 2001-010, the Commission approved Ohio District’s late payment charge. Case No. 2005-00425 and TFS 2005-02023 concern revisions to certain Ohio District’s non-recurring charges. The Commission has alleged in its Order of December 3, 2020 in Case No. 2020-00167 that in making these revisions Ohio District removed its late payment charge from its filed rate schedules. These records will provide historical context and are critical to the Commission obtaining a full and complete understanding of the issues this investigation presents.
