Please find enclosed and accept for filing Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc.'s quarterly Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA"). The data is submitted pursuant to the requirements of the Gas Cost Adjustment Provision contained in Columbia's tariff for its March quarterly adjustment and the Commission's Order of November 24, 2020 in Columbia's last GCA filing, Case No. 2020-00355. Also included is the information requested in Appendix B of that same Order. In accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, and the Commission's Order of March 16, 2020 in Case No. 2020-00085, I certify that the electronically filed documents are a true and accurate copy of the same documents to be filed in paper medium once the State of Emergency has ceased; that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means; and that one paper copy of this filing will be filed by hand-delivery with the Commission once the State of Emergency has ceased.

Columbia proposes to increase its current rates to tariff sales customers by \$0.1590 per Mcf effective with its March 2021 billing cycle on March 1, 2021. The increase is composed of a decrease of (\$0.4543) per Mcf in the Average Commodity Cost of Gas, an increase of \$0.8429 per Mcf in the Average Demand Cost of Gas, an decrease of (\$0.0080) per Mcf in the Balancing Adjustment, and a decrease of (\$0.2216) in the Actual Cost Adjustment.
