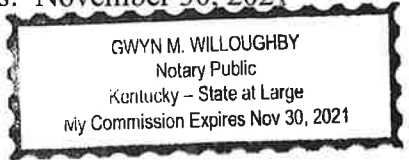

STAFF'S POST-HEARING REQUEST FOR INFORMATION DATED 05/20/21

REQUEST 1

RESPONSIBLE PARTY: Julia J. Tucker

Request 1. For the two-year review period, provide the total that EKPC spent, minus any Auction Revenue Rights already allocated to EKPC, for Financial Transmission Rights that EKPC purchased. Compare this amount to the total cost of fuel for the two-year review period.

Response 1. From November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2020, EKPC spent \$84,795 for Financial Transmission Rights ("FTRs"). EKPC received \$4,332,520 in revenue from Auction Revenue Rights ("ARRs"). The net revenue during this time period was \$4,247,725. During this same time period, EKPC spent \$313,432,107 on fuel, \$250,765,394 in purchased power fuel costs, \$6,614,836 in fuel costs for outside sales and \$747,904 in over/under recovery. The net total fuel expense included in its Fuel Adjustment Clause during the two-year review period was \$556,834,761, as compared to the \$4,245,725 net revenue received from ARRs.
