MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5, Estill County Water District No. 1 ("Estill District") moves to extend the permitted time to apply for an adjustment of its rates for water service to December 1, 2023, or to 30 days from the date on which the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA") establishes a final amortization commencement date and final payment schedule for KIA Loan F20-013, whichever is earlier.

In support of its Motion, Estill District states:

- 1. On June 3, 2022, the Public Service Commission ("Commission") ordered Estill District to apply for an adjustment of its rates for water service within one year.
- 2. After the issuance of that Order, Estill District engaged the services of Rural Community Assistance Partnership ("RCAP") to prepare an application for rate adjustment to be filed pursuant to the Commission's alternative rate adjustment procedures. It selected the calendar year ending December 31, 2022 as its test period to ensure that the proposed rates would reflect Estill District's most recent financial and operating conditions, including the completion of the

water system improvements that the Commission approved in Cases No. 2021-00064 and No. 2021-00207.¹ At the time it obtained RCAP's services and determined that calendar year 2022 should be used as the test period, Estill District reasonably expected that these projects would be completed by December 31, 2022 and that a final amortization commencement date for KIA Loan F20-013 would be established before the June 3, 2023 deadline.

- 3. On December 5, 2019, KIA Board of Directors authorized a loan not to exceed \$2,399,450 ("Loan F20-013") to Estill District to finance the construction of the Phase 11 System Improvements and Meter Purchase and Replacement Project, which involved a series of system improvements to enhance its ability to locate and repair leaks within its distribution system, as well as replace substandard stream crossings water service lines and aging metering equipment. In Case No. 2021-00064, Estill District applied for authorization to enter an Assistance Agreement with KIA to implement Loan F20-013 and a certificate of public convenience and necessity to execute the first contract for construction of the planned system improvements. On April 8, 2021, the Commission granted the requested relief.
- 4. On May 27, 2021, Estill District executed an Assistance Agreement with KIA for Loan F20-013. Pursuant to the Assistance Agreement's terms, Estill District is permitted to draw funds for the proposed system improvements and is required to make interest payments on these borrowed funds beginning six months after its first draw of funds. It is not required to make full principal and interest payments until one year after the initiation of operations of the financed system improvements. The issuance of a final loan payment schedule and determination of the date of the first principal and interest payment ("amortization commencement date") was to be

determined upon the closeout of the loan. When the Assistance Agreement was executed, KIA and Estill District assumed that the proposed system improvements would be completed and principal and interest payments on Loan F20-013 would begin on June 1, 2022.

- 5. On June 25, 2021, the Commission in Case No. 2021-00207 granted Estill District a certificate of public convenience and necessity to execute the second contract for construction of the planned system improvements and the purchase and installation of new residential water meters.
- 6. Due to circumstances beyond Estill District's control, the proposed system improvements were not completed by June 1, 2022. The Kentucky Division of Water's inspection of these system improvements, which the Assistance Agreement requires as a prerequisite to final loan closeout, occurred on April 20, 2023. These improvements were only certified as completed on May 19, 2023. See Exhibit A.
- 7. KIA continues to report that Loan F20-013 remains open and is not yet ready for closeout. Currently, approximately \$25,000 of Loan F20-013 funds remain available for disbursement. Estill District expects to request disbursement of those funds by June 5 and to receive the final disbursement of funds by July 15. After disbursement of these funds, closeout can occur. Once loan closeout has been completed, KIA will establish a final amortization commencement date and issue a final payment schedule for Loan F20-013. KIA Staff has advised Estill District that the issuance of a final payment schedule will likely occur in the third quarter or early fourth quarter of this year.
- 8. The lack of a known and definite amortization commencement date and payment schedule poses a significant problem. Estill District wishes to recover the debt service costs related

to KIA Loan F20-013 through general rates.² 807 KAR 5:076, Section 9, requires that such costs, which are an adjustment to test period operations, must be "known and measurable." To be known and measurable, a proposed adjustment must be supported by documentary evidence. Without a known and definite amortization commencement date or a final payment schedule, however, Estill District will be unable to demonstrate that the principal and interest payments for KIA Loan F20-013 are known and measurable and thus qualify for rate recovery.

- 9. Estill District requests that the deadline for filing an application for rate adjustment be extend by 180 days, or to 30 days after the establishment of a final amortization commencement date and issuance of final payment schedule for KIA Loan F20-013, whichever is earlier, to ensure that Estill District's principal and interest payments for that loan are clearly known and measurable and thus eligible for recovery through rates. The requested extension will permit Estill District to propose rates that reflect its most current cost for providing water service and the likely cost of service at the time a final decision on its proposed rate adjustment is rendered. If the requested extension is granted, Estill District will provide monthly updates on its efforts to obtain a definite amortization commencement date from KIA for Loan F20-013.
- 10. Estill District and RCAP have worked diligently to prepare an application for an adjustment of rates and the application is complete in most respects. An application can be

repair work. It determined that the best and most productive use of surcharge proceeds should be for equipment and personnel. As of this date, no surcharge funds have been used for interest payments on KIA Loan F20-013.

promptly filed as soon as the final amortization commencement date and loan payment schedule

from KIA for Loan F20-013 is known.

11. Estill District intends to submit no later than August 1, 2023 in Case No. 2019-

00119 its plan for using the existing water loss reduction surcharge proceeds and to apply for

authorization for expend those proceeds in accordance with that plan. To the extent that the

Commission wishes to proceed with its announced intention to review the status of the surcharge,

the submission of this plan and request for authorization provides an opportunity to begin such a

review immediately and without waiting for the filing of Estill District's application for rate

adjustment.

12. Estill District's motion is made in good faith and is not made for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, Estill County Water District No. 1 requests that:

1. Grant its Motion for an Extension of Time to file an application for rate adjustment;

2. Amend its Order of June 3, 2022 in Case No. 2021-00064 to permit Estill District

to file its application for adjustment of rates no later than December 1, 2023 or 30 days after the

establishment of a final amortization commencement date and final payment schedule for KIA

Loan F20-013, whichever is earlier, and,

3. Grant any and all such other relief to which Estill District may be entitled.


