**CASE NO. 2021-00066**

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**Item 1)** Refer to the Application, Exhibit 2, Fifth Revised Sheet No. 32 and Second Revised Sheet No. 32B.

- a. Refer to Kenergy’s Response to Commission Staff’s First Request for Information (Staff’s First Request), Item 3a. Explain why Kenergy is including language regarding self-read meters if there are no self-read meters.
- b. Explain when a remote special meter would not occur and instead a trip would occur.
- c. Explain whether Kenergy is willing to clarify the difference in cost between a Special Meter Reading Charge and a Remote Meter Reading Charge to the customer when one is requested.

**Response)**

- a. Language regarding Special Meter Reading Charge (d) can be removed on sheet 32. Remote Special Meter Reading Charge can also be removed on sheet 32B. These charges are no longer applicable.
- b. Not all of Kenergy’s AMI meters are equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect capabilities.
- c. See response to (a) above. Special Meter Reading Charge information should be removed from Kenergy’s tariff.

**Response)** Not all of Kenergy's AMI meters are equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect capabilities.

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**Item 3)** Refer to the Application, Exhibit 2, Third Revised Sheet No. 32 (Exh. B) and Kenergy's Response to Staff's First Request, Item 3d. If all meters are AMI, explain why Turn-On, terminations, disconnects, and reconnects are not handled remotely.

**Response)** Not all of Kenergy's AMI meters are equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect capabilities. AMI meters equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect capabilities are more expensive than standard AMI meters, so Kenergy has limited their installation to accounts that typically generate more trips for servicemen. Some examples include: apartments, seasonal accounts, accounts that have previously been disconnected then reconnected, and prepaid accounts. Kenergy currently has approximately 11,500 active meters installed with remote disconnect switches.

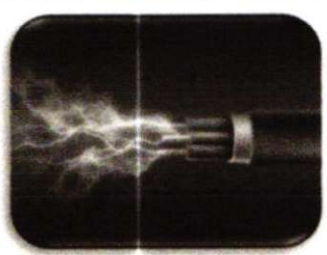
