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Not all of Kenergy's AMI meters are equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect Response) capabilities. AMI meters equipped with remote disconnect/reconnect capabilities are more expensive than standard AMI meters, so Kenergy has limited their installation to accounts that typically generate more trips for servicemen. Some examples include: apartments, seasonal accounts, accounts that have previously been disconnected then reconnected, and prepaid accounts. Kenergy currently has approximately 11,500 active meters installed with remote disconnect switches.




