to set up the lease arrangement, which they did.

The court also approved other budget amendments that accepted grant money that paid for 55 percent of the cost of newly purchased vehicles for the sheriff's department, and approved

the Alcohol Beverage Control's funding of the other 45 percent of that cost. So Phelps said the new patrol vehicles didn't cost the county's general budget anything.

Also approved were the advertising for and participation in the bidding process for

road salt for the coming year.

Phelps said the Governor's request this week that the president declare an emergency with regard to the snow, ice and rain events that recently paralyzed the county's business and damaged roads and buildings in the county would help the county recoup some of the overtime hours, money spent and more,

if approved.

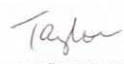

KY Tax Return Deadline Extended to May 17

The Department of Revenue released the announcement late last week that they will extend the deadline of 2020 individual tax returns to May 17, as requested by the governor.

This extension follows the income tax relief provisions issued March 17 by the federal Internal Revenue Service moving their April 15 deadline to May 17.

According to the Department of Revenue individual income tax payments for the last tax year, without penalties and interest, regardless of the amount owed.

Individual taxpayers who need additional time to file beyond the May 17 deadline can request a Kentucky filing extension until Oct. 15 by filing

the appropriate form to extend until October 15 to file their 2020 tax return but does not grant an extension of time to pay taxes due.

Taxpayers should pay their Kentucky income tax due by May 17, 2021, to avoid interest and penalties.

Individual who are required to file estimated income tax forms for

income in 2021 estimated payments are still due on April 15. They reiterated that Kentucky's tax filing relief applies only to individual income taxes that normally would be due April 15, 2021. It does not apply to corporation income tax, limited liability entity tax, withholding tax, sales and use tax, or other types of state taxes.
