Please accept this cost estimate reply to The Commission Staff's first request for information in the above case, question #3 and #4.

Enclosed you will find a map showing Shelby Energy's closest distribution facilities depicted in green along and near George's Creek Road. The solid blue line indicates 1600 feet of overhead electric distribution facilities Shelby Energy would need to construct to serve the request of the Whitlow family at a total estimated cost of \$17,384 including cost of clearing right-of-way. Of this amount and according to our current tariff's, the Whitlow family would be responsible for \$14,312 prior to our construction of facilities.
