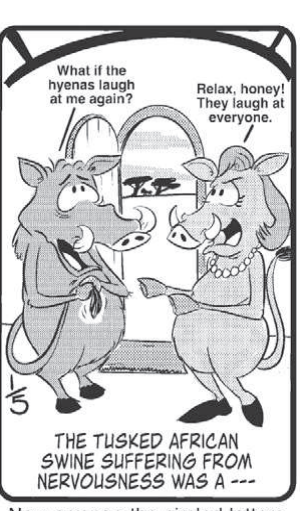

Do you need assistance with your heating costs?

Beginning January 10, 2022, your local Community Action Office will be assisting families of low-income with the LIHEAP CRISIS Program. The program will end March 31, 2022 or sooner if funds are expended.

To be eligible for Crisis funds you must be in a heating crisis. You must have a past due/disconnect notice from the electric or natural gas company, or be out of bulk fuel within 4 days if using propane, fuel oil or kerosene, or wood, or a formal eviction notice from your landlord if heating expenses are included in the rent.

The family income level must be at or below the 150% federal poverty level. The benefit levels are up to \$400.00 for natural gas or electric and/or up to 200 gallons of propane, fuel oil or kerosene or 2 cords of wood. Based on the availability of funding.

You will need; ID, proof of income for the entire family for the previous month (pay stubs, employer verification, award letters), and social security numbers, birth dates for all in household, and a past due/disconnect notice or bulk fuel statement. Applicants heating with propane, fuel oil, kerosene or wood must verify their physical address.
