Rhodes Creek Solar, LLC, is proposing to construct and operate a solar energy project in Hardin County, Kentucky. The proposed Rhodes Creek Solar Project will be located on approximately 869 acres along Highway 86, near the community of Cecilia in Hardin County, Kentucky. Additionally, Rhodes Creek Solar, LLC is proposing to build a transmission line from the project substation approximately 1.5 miles to Kentucky Utilities Black Branch to Hardinsburg transmission line.

A public meeting, to inform the community about the project will take place on Thursday, April 1, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Cecilia Ruritan Pavilion at 422 Federal Street, Cecilia, KY 42724 via Zoom.

In order to comply with current state and federal guidelines, the project meeting will be accessible as follows:

The public is encouraged to participate via the online meeting. In-person attendance at the public meeting will be consistent with guidelines and directives from the CDC and the Office of the Governor in effect at the time of the meeting regarding such meetings, including, but not limited to, social distancing and the requirement that masks be properly worn at all times. In order to allow for social distancing, the number of attendees at the in-person meeting will be limited and spaces allocated to the public on a first-come, first-served basis, and include instructions for how to sign up for the available spaces.

The power generated by the project will be linked to the electric transmission grid via a 1.5 mile transmission line to be built, which is also part of the project, connecting from the Project substation to the KU transmission line.

The events will be an opportunity for us to answer your questions about different aspects of solar development. To accommodate the guidelines recommended by the state of Kentucky, we are using an outdoor venue and you are free to come and go as you please between the hours of 5:30 p.m.- 6:30 p.m. During this time people will be allowed to enter the event, gather an information packet and check-in. After registration, you will have an opportunity to do a self-guided tour of display boards and speak with our staff regarding the Rhudes Creek Solar Farm.

Please feel free to bring your family members to this event, as we are looking to answer any questions or concerns you may have regarding the project. To RSVP for the event, please call **(270) 370-3531**.



Rhudes Creek Solar plans to construct and operate the 100 MW solar photovoltaic facility near your property. The solar technology used is photovoltaic, and the solar panels sit on racks that are up to 15 feet tall that rotate once per day on a North-South axis to track the sun throughout the day. The facility will contain solar panels, inverters, a battery energy storage system, a project substation transformer, an associated balance of wiring system, and an approximately 1.5 mile transmission line from the solar project to the KU transmission line. The Rhudes Creek Solar Project will be sited on approximately 869 acres of land.

Rhudes Creek Solar is required to file an application for construction and operation of the proposed facility. This application is subject to the approval of the Kentucky State Siting Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting, which can be reached at P.O. Box 615, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602-0615, or via phone at (502) 564-3940.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be following the State of Kentucky guidelines for gatherings under 250 people, as well as ibV's best practices for hosting a public event. We selected the Cecilia Ruritan Club Pavilion because it was outdoor venue that would allow enough room for adequate social distancing during the event.

- *Appropriate social distancing will be required of all attendees who are not in the same family unit.*
- *The event will be limited to no more than 50 people at a time.*
- *Masks will be required for all attendees and ibV staff -- no exceptions.*
- *We will provide masks for those who do not have their own.*
- *Provide Adequate Hand Sanitizer and Encourage Hand Washing*
