Public Notice Evidence of Application

The City of Elizabethtown, KY Stormwater Management Department, hereby gives notice of the City of Elizabethtown's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located along Freeman Lake Road. Specifically, the flood hazard information shall be revised along Tributary 3 of Freeman Creek from approximately 100 feet south of the southern crossing of Freeman Lake Road near the intersection of Freeman Lake Road and Dearbourne Court northward to a point approximately 200 feet south of Dogwood Drive.

As a result of the revision, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall increase and decrease, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall widen and narrow within the area of revision.

Maps and detailed analysis of the revision can be reviewed at the City Hall offices of the Stormwater Management at 200 West Dixie, Elizabethtown, KY 42701. Interested persons may call Rita Davis, Stormwater Director at 270-763-4217 for additional information from September 1, 2021 to October 1, 2021.

ATTENTION FUEL VENDORS: The Central Kentucky Community Action Council, Inc. NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Rhudes Creek Solar, LLC plans to construct and operate the 100 MW solar photovoltaic facility. Rhudes Creek Solar Project will be located along Hardinsburg Road (KY-86), in Cecilia, Hardin County, Kentucky. The proposed Rhudes Creek Solar Project will consist of approximately 750 acres of solar photovoltaic panels and associated racking, inverters, and a project substation transformer.

For interconnection, Rhudes Creek Solar proposes to construct a 138kV nonregulated transmission line of approximately 1½ miles in length which will connect the project substation to a new switchyard on the existing 138kV Black Branch to Hardinsburg transmission line. Under a provisional large generator interconnection agreement, Louisville Gas & Electric/Kentucky Utilities will engineer, procure, and construct the interconnection facilities and network upgrades required to interconnect the proposed solar generator.

Rhudes Creek Solar, LLC is required to file an application for construction and operation of the proposed facility. This application is subject to the approval of the Kentucky State Siting Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting, which can be reached at P.O. Box 615, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602-0615, or via phone at (502) 564-3940.

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A request for a local public hearing or local public information meeting shall be made by at least three (3) interested persons who reside in the county or municipal corporation in which the pipeline, plant, or transmission line is proposed to be located. The request shall be made in writing and shall be filed within thirty (30) days following the filing of a completed application.



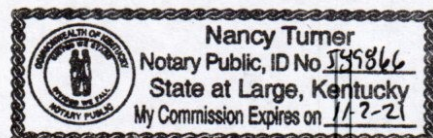

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Re: Rhudes Creek Solar Notice of Application

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In an effort to provide information to the public, the proposed facility and its applicants have previously hosted two public meetings and one virtual meeting about the project on October 6th, 2020, and April 1, 2021, at the Cecilia Ruritan Pavilion, located at 422 Federal Street in Cecilia, KY. For those who were unable to attend in-person meeting, a virtual community meeting via Zoom was held immediately following the meeting in April.

The solar technology used is photovoltaic, and the solar panels sit on racks that rotate once per day on a North-South axis to track the sun throughout the day. The facility will contain solar photovoltaic arrays, inverters, transformers, balance of plant components, a project substation, security fencing, maintenance roads, and a 1.5 mile gen-tie line to interconnect to LG&E/KU's transmission network. The Rhudes Creek Solar Project will be sited on approximately 750 acres of land.
