Provide a map that shows the existing KU and Blue Grass Energy Cooperative Corporation (Blue Grass Energy) distribution facilities and the location of the proposed Blue Grass Energy line to the Northern residence and the alternative KU line. Submit this map on paper as well as sending a scanned PDF copy.
- A-1. See attached map of KU and Blue Grass Energy distribution facilities.

Upon review of the signed site map, it was determined that the line indicated as "Existing Territorial Line" did not correspond with the official KU Service Territory Boundary on the Richmond North Quadrangle map as filed with the Public Service Commission. A correction was made to indicate the official boundary. The proposed adjustment to the territory boundary was subsequently updated to reflect this correction. Specifically point A was adjusted to the location where the original proposed change crossed the official boundary at 37° 50' 34.23"N 84° 21' 21.27"W and the line between the original points B and C was extended directly to the southwest for approximately 52 ft. to meet the boundary at 37° 50' 23.7"N 84° 21' 31.56"W. See attached signed revised site map notated as REVISION 04-20-21 that replaces the original filed site map in this case.

Quoted herein as "An extension to a permanent residence of one thousand (1,000) feet or less shall be made by Blue Grass Energy to its existing distribution line without charge for a prospective member who shall apply for and agree to use the service for one year or more and provides guarantee for such service." This project meets these requirements.

- Q-3. Provide all correspondence with Mr. David Northern concerning the provision of electrical service to his property located at 420 Whitehall Shrine Road, Richmond, Kentucky.
- A-3. KU: KU communication consisted of one telephone conversation with Mr. Northern. The conversation discussed Mr. Northern's electric requirements for a new home that he was planning to construct within KU's certified electric service territory. KU informed Mr. Northern that it was happy to provide service, however his contribution would be tens of thousands of dollars due to the extension distance, as well as the tree clearing and easements required. KU learned that Blue Grass was already providing electric service to Mr. Northem's barn, which is located wholly within Blue Grass' certified electric service territory. Due to the existing Blue Grass distribution facilities, KU informed Mr. Northern that his expense would be much less to have Blue Grass provide service rather than for KU to provide service.

Blue Grass Energy Response: Blue Grass Energy met with Mr. Northern near the end of 2020 and informed him that KU would need to provide permission and the acceptable documentation for Blue Grass Energy to provide electrical facilities to the permanent residence being constructed in existing KU service territory. Mr. Northern contacted KU and sought their input on this subject. KU and Blue Grass Energy subsequently communicated with one another through email and telephone to move through the boundary adjustment process.
