Cawood Water is writing today regarding order 20240206_PSC_Order that was in Case No:2021-00150. The QIIP that was filed to the PSC on July 30, 2021, at 11:35:45 AM, (see attached file). Since the QIIP was filled Cawood Water has made some Management changes, with that CWD is asking for clarity on the order referenced above. CWD took it as that we can install valves bypass meter and leak detection meters and zone meters, pay for them out of the surcharge account and then submit it along with our monthly Water Loss and surcharge report. Also, CWD would like to find out if the surcharge money could be used for meters within the system that is no longer reading and in that causing water loss. Also attached to an invoice format that CWD will be used for work done on the QIIP work that will be done.

In this we would like to give a report on what we have done with funding from KIA CWD which has replaced 2.01 miles of troubled line on US 421, also replaced the key pressure reducing valve on US 3001. That regulates the pressure from Cawood to the intersection of US 421 and US 72 that have regulated the pressure in that zone to help in leaks (this is in the QIIP 2C).

CWD is very eager to get water loss under control. We have been working diligently to reduce it and get it lowered. In saying this, CWD has fixed several leaks throughout the last year with the guidance of the Board and management. The plant is now gone from running 720 hours a month to running 590 hours a month and is still working on furthering that ill water loss is 15% or lower. So, in saying this the reduction of hours run equals to the saving of 2,352,600 gallons produced.
