Question #3: How much has the utility paid on the intake system a) 2020 calendar year; b) to present date?

<u>2020</u>

Engineering - \$26,328.40 (Note 1) Pump, River Screen & VFD Purchase - \$294,707.70 Extra Hoses, Connectors and Clamps associated with Pump Purchase - \$15,078.55 TOTAL - \$336,114.65

<u>2021</u>

Engineering - \$10,337.80 Pump and Motor Repair -\$15,459.99 **TOTAL - \$25,797.79**

Note 1 - Raw Water Intake (RWI) and Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Improvements are one project. Assumes 33% of engineering cost assigned to RWI and 67% of costs assigned to WTP.

Question #4: What is the current balance of the accounts payable that is 30 days or more past due that has been accrued subsequent to the debt service surcharge approval?

Per the PSC Order dated Mar 16, 2018, page 4, \$808,209 was the District's accounts payable balance as of 12/31/2017. As of May 2021, long term vendor debt is at \$732,898. We have included a chart that may be helpful.
