JOINT APPLICANTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Come now West Carroll Water District (“West Carroll”) and the City of Carrollton on behalf of Carrollton Utilities (“Carrollton”) (collectively, the “Joint Applicants”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and requests an extension of time to file the documents requested in the Commission’s April 28, 2021 Order. As grounds for this motion the Joint Applicants respectfully state as follows:


The Commission’s Order required the Joint Applicants to file within 60 days from the date of the Order, a financial and statistical report as required by 807 KAR 5:006 Section 4 for the reporting period from January 1, 2021 to the date of the merger. The Joint Applicants state that the effective date of the merger will be July 1, 2021 to coincide with the new fiscal year of Carrollton Utilities. The deadline contained in the Order will be prior to the merger taking place. In order to provide the required financial and statistical information through the date of the merger, the Joint Applicants will need to wait until after the merger occurs to compile the requested information. The Joint Applicants request a thirty-day extension to file the required report, which would make

the filing due on July 27, 2021. This would allow the Joint Applicants enough time to gather the requested information after the July 1, 2021 merger date.

WHEREFORE, the Joint Applicants respectfully request a thirty-day extension to file the required financial and statistical report.

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
