**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF  
REQUEST FOR CERTAIN RELIEF**


Comes now Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., (“Columbia”), by counsel, and does hereby give notice of its withdrawal of its request for certain relief originally set forth in its Application, respectfully stating as follows:

Columbia filed its Application in this matter on May 28, 2021 and the Application was accepted for filing by the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) on June 2, 2021. Along with its Application, Columbia tendered a Motion for Deviation concerning certain engineering drawings, plans and specifications for a new safety training center that was to be located at Columbia’s headquarters in Lexington, Kentucky. As part of the Application, Columbia sought a Certificate of Public Convenience and

Necessity (“CPCN”) to construct the proposed facilities. In an Order entered on August 24, 2021, the Commission denied Columbia’s Motion for Deviation. In light of that Order, Columbia is electing to withdraw that portion of its Application which sought a CPCN for the proposed safety training facilities. This decision will simplify the issues that are presented in the case and promote overall administrative efficiency. Columbia will prepare a revised revenue requirement that takes into account the rate impact of this adjustment and file it in the record when it tenders its rebuttal testimony.
