RESOLUTION NO. 2021-05-03

A RESOLUTION OF BEECH GROVE WATER SYSTEM WATER RATES TO OFFSET WEST DAVIESS WATER DISTRICTS'WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the West Daviess Water District supplies potable water to Beech Grove Water System a wholesale basis.

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2021 West Daviess Water District informed Beech Grove Water System that it would be increasing its wholesale rate.

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from West Daviess Water District during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to Beech Grove Water System will be \$ 995.00.

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that Beech Grove Water System take action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with West Daviess Water District's wholesale rate increase

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for Beech Grove Water System to increase its water rates to commensurate with West Daviess Water District's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA")

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BEECH GROVE WATER SYSTEM DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS

FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is \$.02 per 1,000gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and set forth in Beech Grove Water System's existing tariff shall be increased by \$.02 per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of Beech Grove Water System shall be as set forth in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in **Exhibit A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after June 1, 2021 upon PSC approval.

Section 5. The President and the Office Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all

documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The President, Office Manager, and all appropriate Beech Grove Water System Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption. Section7.
