

Ordinance# 2021-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE REGULATORY LICENSE FEE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF LEITCHFIELD, KENTUCKY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022.

WHEREAS, the City of Leitchfield, Kentucky (hereinafter "City") is authorized to impose a regulatory license fee on the sale of alcoholic beverages of each establishment therein licensed to sell alcoholic beverages pursuant to the KRS 243.075 and City of Leitchfield Ordinance #2018-16 Section 20 and Ordinance #2018-17, Section 1, Article IV; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the regulatory license fee revenues from the prior fiscal year as well as the expenditures related to the additional policing, regulatory and administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City, with a copy of income statement being attached hereto and incorporated basels by treferes as and herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that the current regulatory license fees are reasonably estimated to somewhat reimburse the City for the additional policing, regulatory and administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Leitchfield, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The regulatory license fee shall be six percent (6%) of gross sales of all alcoholic beverages sold by the drink, by retail sales of packaged distilled spirits and wine, and by retail sales of packaged malt beverages.

SECTION TWO: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason declared illegal, unconstitutional, or otherwise invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remaining portions hereof. **SECTION THREE:** If any provision of this Ordinance is in conflict with provisions of existing Ordinances or laws, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Leitchfield, Kentucky, that the provisions

of this Ordinance shall govern, and such provisions in existing Ordinances or laws in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded. This Ordinance is effective upon final reading and publication.
