

**RESPONSIBLE PARTY:           Andy Legg**

**Request 3.**           If any money remains in the surcharge account, provide the current amount as of the date of this response and explain how Morgan District would propose to use the funds.

**Response 3.**           As of the date of filing this response, the balance remaining in the surcharge account is \$102.03. The remaining balance is so small that it would not be a sufficient amount to use towards any leak detection equipment or other items that could be recovered through the surcharge. Therefore, Morgan District does not have any proposals for spending the remaining balance.
