Response 3. As of the date of filing this response, the balance remaining in the surcharge account is \$102.03. The remaining balance is so small that it would not be a sufficient amount to use towards any leak detection equipment or other items that could be recovered through the surcharge. Therefore, Morgan District does not have any proposals for spending the remaining balance.
