

Notice is hereby given that the City of Jackson proposes to increase its rate for wholesale water service effective July 1, 2020. Documentation will be filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase the rate as follows:

	<u>Current Rate</u>	<u>New Rate</u>	<u>\$ Change</u>	<u>% Change</u>
Water Rate per 1,000 gallons	\$3.85	\$3.92	\$0.07	1.7%

The purposed effective date is July 1, 2020. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged the current rate. Water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed new rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Jackson but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be changed that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.



Per City of Jackson Ordinance 52.16, adjustments to water rates are to be levied in July of each year and are to be tied to the Consumer Price Index for the previous federal fiscal year. The Consumer Price Index increased 1.7 percent for the federal fiscal year ending September 2019.

Please administer the necessary processes to adjust the water rates to match the increase indicated in the CPI.
