STATUS REPORT

On September 23, 2021, the Commission approved the proposed corporate reorganization that will result in the indirect acquisition of control of Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. by LDC Funding, LLC, upon the merger of LDC Holding LLC into LDC Funding, LLC. Ordering paragraph 3 states that if the reorganization “has not been completed within six months of the date of this Order, the Joint Applicants shall provide a written status report to the Commission every 30 days thereafter.”

Since the Joint Applicants’ March 3, 2022 status report, the Administrative Law Judge in the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission proceeding approved the proposed restructuring described in the application and as clarified by a joint settlement, without modification. This approval was issued on March 9, 2022. Following expiration of the time period for filing exceptions, the decision will go to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for final approval. The Joint Applicants will complete the reorganization once approval from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission is obtained.
