STATUS REPORT

On September 23, 2021, the Commission approved the proposed corporate reorganization that will result in the indirect acquisition of control of Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. by LDC Funding, LLC, upon the merger of LDC Holding LLC into LDC Funding, LLC. Ordering paragraph 3 states that if the reorganization “has not been completed within six months of the date of this Order, the Joint Applicants shall provide a written status report to the Commission every 30 days thereafter.”

Since the Joint Applicants’ May 4, 2022 status report, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission in a May 12, 2022 Order adopted as its action the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Conrad A. Johnson, dated March 9, 2022, thereby approving the intercompany restructuring, as clarified by the terms and conditions of the Settlement.
