Activation will begin on date of installation, and in use no less than (1) one year before terminating service.

Ordinance 17-2 is amended to the extent necessary by this Amendment.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CENTERTOWN, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY OF KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18-1, A SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES OF THE CENTERTOWN WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Centertown, Kentucky, a home rule municipality, operates a municipal water system for the benefit of the citizens of the incorporated boundaries of the city, and also, for the Centertown community area, including users outside the incorporated boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates additional expenses by reason of improvements made and to be made to the water systems of the City of Centertown, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centertown, Kentucky, has made an examination of the rates and charges for water services and has found some adjustment to said rates to be in order;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CENTERTOWN KENTUCKY, that from and After the effective date of this Ordinance 18-1 shall be amended as follows:

Section 1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance there shall be charged to and collected from all parties making use of the water system rendered by the City of Centertown,

Monthly water service rates and charges in accordance with the following schedule:

A. Rate for water service inside the City's incorporated boundaries:	
First 2,000 gallons (minimum)	\$28.89
Over 2,000 gallons	11.77
B. Rate for water service outside City's incorporated boundaries:	
First 2,000 gallons (minimum)	\$46.01
Over 2,000 gallons	15.30
C. Rate for industrial water service inside or outside City's incorporated boundaries	
First 2,000 gallons (minimum)	\$86.25
Over 2,000 gallons	19.26

Section 2. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

Section 4. Water rates will be reviewed annually for adjustments.

3 killed, 1 injured in stabbing in northern Kentucky

WALTON, Ky. (AP) — A woman and two children were killed and a man was injured in a stabbing in northern Kentucky, officials said.

Deputies responding to an apartment in Walton on Sunday evening arrived to find two adults and two children with multiple stab wounds, the Boone County Sheriff's Office said in a statement. The woman, Monique S. Pena, 31, and children, 12-year-old Nikki Romero Pena and 3-year-old Katie Farrell-Pena, were pronounced dead at the scene, the statement said. The man, Matthew Farrell, 36, was taken to a hospital with serious injuries, the statement said.

Farrell suffered stab wounds to his torso, neck and upper body and has been discharged from the

hospital, authorities said on Monday. He is cooperating with the investigation.

The stabbing was isolated to the residence

and deputies said they do not believe any outside suspects were involved. The investigation is continuing.

Estate Planning: Time To Act

Getting the ball rolling on your estate plan or farm transition is one of the hardest things to do. Hopefully by now you have had meaningful conversations about your estate with your heir(s) and have assembled a team of professionals to help you with the transition. If not, you should do so before putting a plan into motion.

Work with your attorney to develop a will that reflects your wishes. Wills are the only way to guarantee a successful transfer of assets to your heir(s). Keep the will in a safe place and make sure your heir(s) know its location. After all the hard work you have put into developing a will, you do not want it somewhere that no one knows about and as a result, cannot produce it after you are gone.

Once your will is in place, now is the time to start incorporating your heir(s) into your business, if you have not already done so. Remember that leaders and managers are trained, not born. Now is the time to share your business' financial records and status. If you work with the Kentucky Farm Business Management program, now is the time to introduce your heir(s) to your farm analyst. It is also a good time to start dividing your farm responsibilities with your heir(s) and fully bringing them into the operation. You may also encourage your heir(s) to take leader-

ship and/or management classes. The University of Kentucky offers great professional development opportunities and resources for young farm managers including the Kentucky Agricultural Leadership Program, MarketReady Program, Center for Crop Diversification and the Kentucky Small Business Development Center. It may be a good idea to start using a calendar or multiyear timeline to set specific goals and completion dates for action items
