**MOTION OF BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION FOR
LEAVE FOR WITNESSES TO PARTICIPATE VIRTUALLY
IN THE JANUARY 20, 2022, HEARING**

1. Comes Big Rivers Electric Corporation (“*Big Rivers*”), by counsel, and respectfully requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“*Commission*”) allow two of Big Rivers’ witnesses, Mr. Paul G. Smith and Mr. John Wolfram, to participate virtually in the upcoming January 20, 2022, hearing in this matter in light of risks and restrictions associated with COVID. These witnesses have participated virtually in several Commission hearings or FERC technical and settlement conferences without incident.

2. In support further of this motion, Big Rivers states that Mr. Smith only sponsored one information request response (Item 3 of the Commission Staff’s First Request for Information, which provides a numerical billing example for an industrial customer for which maintenance and back-up service is provided during a month), and that the time commitment required for in-person attendance is substantial relative to this single response.
