Pursuant 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(1), McCreary County Water District (“McCreary District” or “the District”) moves for an additional seven (7) days in which to response to Commission Staff’s First Request for Information in the above-referenced matters. In support of its motion, McCreary District states:


1. Commission Staff’s Request seeks a large amount of information and documents. The Request contains 31 separate requests, many with several subparts.
2. Several of the requests seek information for various aspects of McCreary District’s operations for each of the four years preceding the test period and deal with both sewer and water operations.
3. While McCreary District is working diligently to meet these requests, the requested extension will permit the District to thoroughly respond to the requests and avoid any errors that might otherwise delay or impede Commission Staff’s review.

4. While the requested delay may require amending the procedural schedule in this matter, it is limited and should not prevent Commission Staff from rendering a report or McCreary District responding to such report prior to the end of the suspension period.

5. The requested extension is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.
