Customer wants her service provider to be Kentucky Power. She said she is within Kentucky Power's boundary and Kentucky Power has confirmed this to her. Customer has lived at the above address for 20 years, and her service has been provided by Big Sandy RECC the entire time she has lived there. She says everybody up the road has Kentucky Power. Her power goes over two hills now, but if it was provided by Kentucky Power it would come in a straight line. She said Big Sandy agreed she is in Kentucky Power's service territory. She did not know why Big Sandy provided the service over 20 years ago if she was in Kentucky Power's territory.

She now wants to disconnect her Big Sandy RECC service and have Kentucky Power provide her service. Both companies told her to call the PSC to approve the change from Big Sandy RECC to Kentucky Power. She said Big Sandy is willing to give her up and Kentucky Power is ready to serve her.

Advised customer that normally boundary issues are settled when service is initially installed. Since she has active service for over 20 years, the cost to install service to her will most likely be borne by her. I asked why this is coming up now if she knew she was in the wrong boundary 20 years ago. At that point I learned her power is currently out, but the Kentucky Power customers have service. She said her electric service has been off for 14 days.

Customer wants her service provider to be Kentucky Power. She said she is well within Kentucky Power's boundary per the maps she found online. She has 12 acres. Kentucky Power wouldn't tell her one way or the other whether she was in their service territory. Customer has lived at the above address for 5 years, but the house is 20 years old. The service has been provided by Big Sandy RECC the entire time. She says everybody up the road has Kentucky Power including her neighbor across the street. Her power goes over two hills now, but if it was provided by Kentucky Power it would come in a straight line.

She now wants to disconnect her Big Sandy RECC service and have Kentucky Power provide her service. Both companies told her to call the PSC to approve the change from Big Sandy RECC to Kentucky Power. Neither company will tell her whose territory she belongs in. Since Big Sandy didn't deny it, she assumes she is in Kentucky Power's territory.

Advised customer that normally boundary issues are settled when service is initially installed. Since there has been active service for over 20 years, the cost to install service to her will most likely be borne by her. She said she will gladly pay whatever it cost. I asked why this is coming up now if she knew she was in the wrong boundary years ago. She said her electric service is off due to the winter storm. She said every time it rains, her power flickers. The Kentucky Power customers have service.

Dear Mr. Overstreet:

Pursuant to your request for records, a copy of which is attached hereto for reference purposes, I have attached four PDF files containing territory maps for Quadrangles 37-F-4 and 38-F-3, located in Johnson County, Kentucky. There are two maps available for each quad: a color map dated 1982 by Kentucky Power and the PSC and signed by both utilities, and a blueprint dated 1991 by the PSC (signed but not dated by the utilities) on an old (1962/1954) base map. These are the legal documents that the PSC has for the electric service areas.


It is important to take into account the old technology ... the 1982 electric service area boundaries on the color map were most likely made by tracing a previous map over a light table; the 1982 maps were digitized by the PSC in 1998 using a digitizing table (not a scanned image that can be enlarged on a monitor as is done today). Generally, the quad maps are only accurate to within + or - 100 feet. Notice that the electric service area boundaries did not match at the quadrangle edges, so the PSC added a short line. It appears that the maps that were submitted in 1991 were in response to the missing electric service area boundary in the upper right hand corner of the 1982 Offutt quad, and that line alone was digitized from the blueprint maps in 1998. The digital lines for the electric service areas have no legal standing.

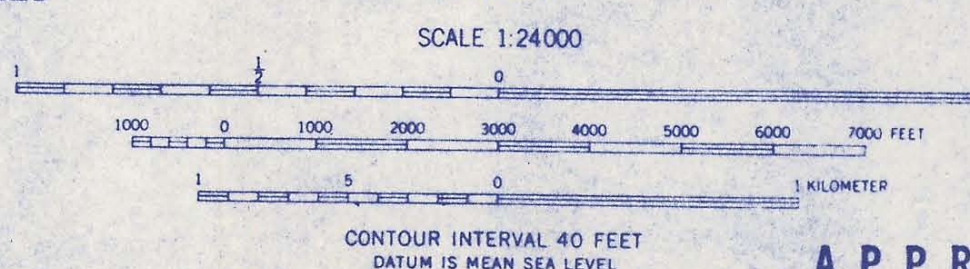
