MOTION ON BEHALF OF RATTLESNAKE RIDGE WATER DISTRICT

Comes now Rattlesnake Ridge Water District, by and through counsel, and hereby Requests for an Enlargement of Time to file its responses to post-hearing data responses and memorandum brief to support its position. In support thereof, Rattlesnake Ridge Water District states as follows:

The Public Service Commission conducted a hearing by video on January 12, 2022. Rattlesnake Ridge Water District (“Rattlesnake Ridge”) received post-hearing data requests which are currently due on or before February 8, 2022. The Public Service Commission also gave Rattlesnake Ridge the option to file a memorandum brief on or before February 15, 2022. Due to unforeseen circumstances and illness, it is unlikely that Rattlesnake Ridge will have their responses completed on or before February 8, 2022.

Several Rattlesnake Ridge employees contracted COVID-19 after the hearing. It has been so shorthanded and under staffed that the new manager, David Gifford, has been required to work in the field in order to maintain infrastructure and repair water leaks. The new office manager, Becky Kitchen, has also been out of the office and unable to help compile documents. Rattlesnake Ridge has also made various changes in management which it mentioned during the video hearing.

Wherefore, Rattlesnake Ridge Water District requests this be taken as its Motion and prays for an additional forty-five (45) days or an additional time deemed appropriate by the Public Service Commission to file its responses and for all relief to which it may appear entitled.
