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## UPDATED RESPONSE OF RATTLESNAKE RIDGE WATER DISTRICT REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

## **COMMISSION ORDER DATED NOVEMBER 7, 2022**

1. APPLICATION: Rattlesnake Ridge shall file an application for a general rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16, or an application for an alternative rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076 within six months of this Order.

Rattlesnake Ridge Water District (hereinafter RRWD) has begun the process toward applying for a rate increase. RRWD has secured the Kentucky Rural Water Association (hereinafter KRWA) to complete the necessary application and same is in process. However, KRWA cannot present an appropriate application without the 2021 audit, which has still not been received by RRWD. RRWD has been assured from the auditor that they will receive same no later than April 6, 2023 (RRWD has been assured that the auditor has all necessary information). At that point, KRWA will be in a better position to complete the application but has indicated to the undersigned attorney that they cannot now meet the May 7, 2023 deadline. KRWA has indicated that they will work diligently to complete as quickly as possible, but did not want to use the 2020 audit information as wants to try to give as accurate as possible application to PSC.

RRWD understands the frustration with not having the audit completed timely. RRWD has approached another accounting firm, has sent them documents, and is awaiting its decision as to whether they will proceed with completing RRWD's 2022 audit. RRWD wants to be proactive in addressing this issue as the current auditor has not understood the importance of completing these audits in a timely manner.

Wherefore, RRWD respectfully requests an extension of time to file the application requested by this Commission's Order dated November 7, 2022.
