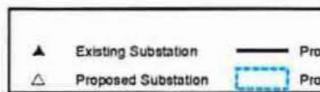


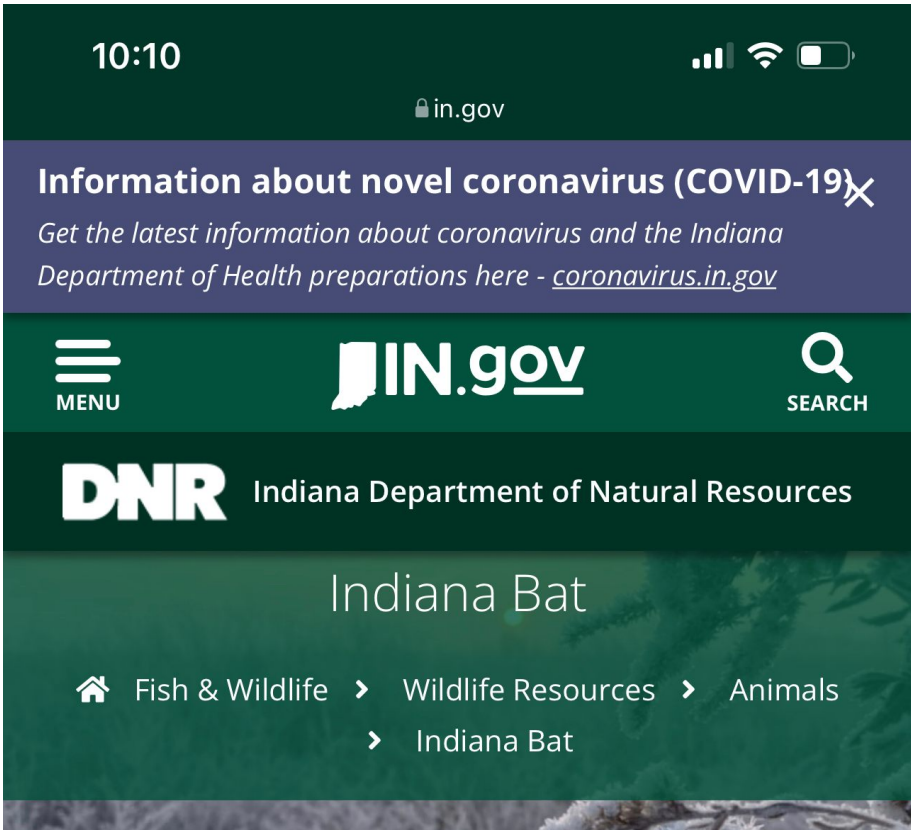

The Indiana bat (*Myotis sodalis*) is both a state and federally endangered species. The species was listed in the late 1960s due to human disturbance of caves that bats use for winter hibernating. Indiana

bats are vulnerable to these disturbances **as they hibernate in large colonies in very few caves.** Bats are beneficial and important components of Indiana’s ecosystem, eating many night-flying insects, including crop pests. Despite the many benefits of bats, people should avoid contact with them and should not handle them. Bats are fragile and human contact can harm them. They also can carry rabies. Dogs and cats can encounter bats, especially those that are sick or injured, and should be vaccinated against rabies.

C) This documents the fact that the Indiana Bats that live on my property hibernate AND are on both Federal and State endangered species lists. This proposed route would endanger their natural habitat.


