Kentucky Power Company’s Notice of Filing

In accordance with Paragraph 6 of the Commission’s March 8, 2022 Order in this proceeding, Kentucky Power files as **EXHIBIT A** to this notice are copies of the acknowledgments from the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection that the Eastern Station Project and the Garrett Station Project, which are a part of the Garrett Area Improvement master project, has been approved for coverage under the Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (KPDES) General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activities (KYR100000). The Company submitted the coverage letter for another part of the Garrett Area Improvement master project, the Garrett – Softshell 138 kV Transmission Rebuild Project, on June 10, 2024. Kentucky Power inadvertently failed to file these within the 30-day requirement set forth in Paragraph 6 of the March 8, 2022 Order and respectfully requests a deviation from this requirement for these permits.

Any person aggrieved by the issuance of a permit final decision may demand a hearing pursuant to KRS 224.10-420(2) within thirty (30) days from the date of the issuance of this letter. Any demand for a hearing on the permit shall be filed in accordance with the procedures specified in KRS 224.10-420, 224.10-440, 224.10-470, and the regulations promulgated thereto. The request for hearing should be submitted in writing to the Energy and Environment Cabinet, Office of Administrative Hearings, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601 and the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Water, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601. For your record keeping purposes, it is recommended that these requests be sent by certified mail. The written request must conform to the appropriate statutes referenced above.
