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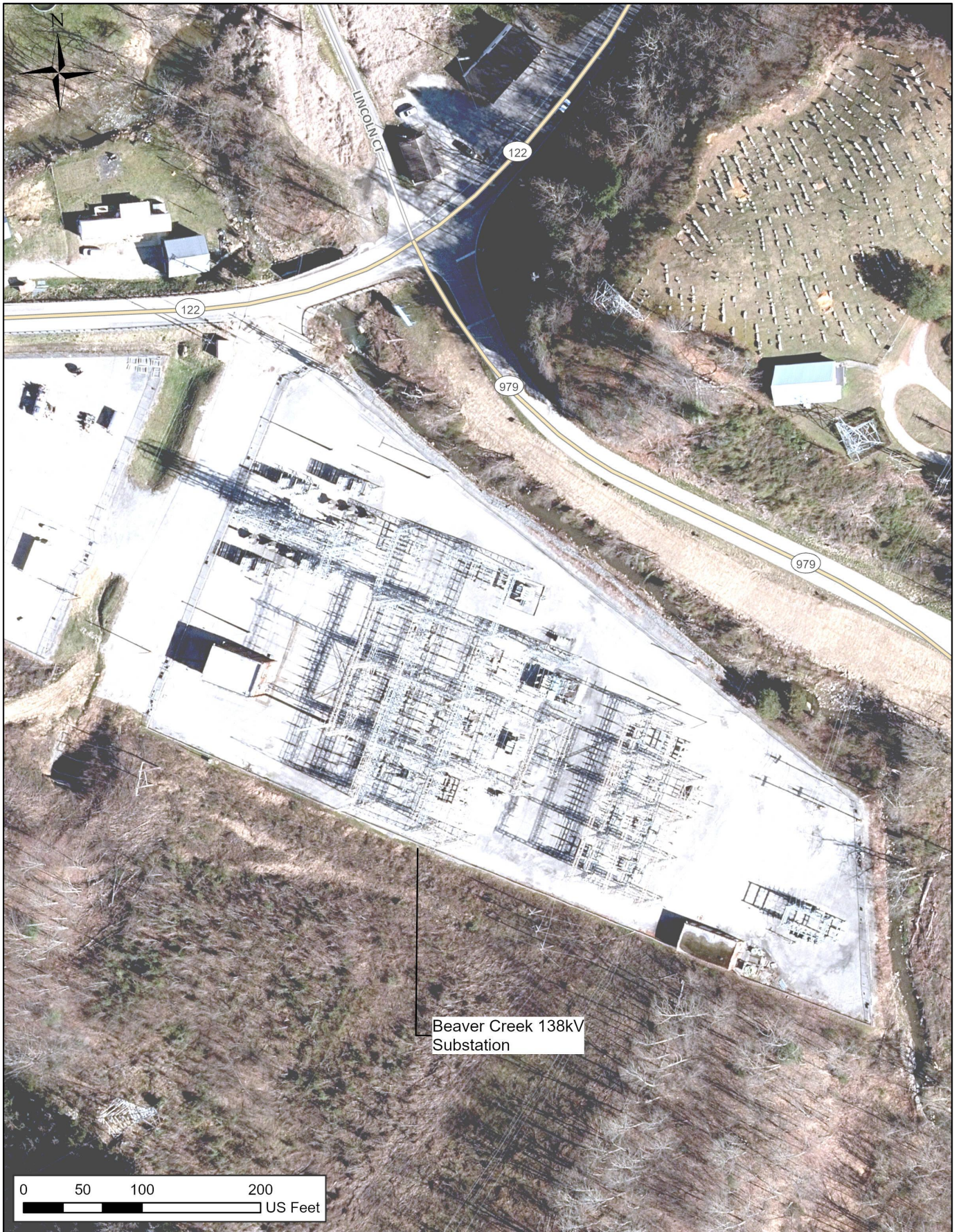

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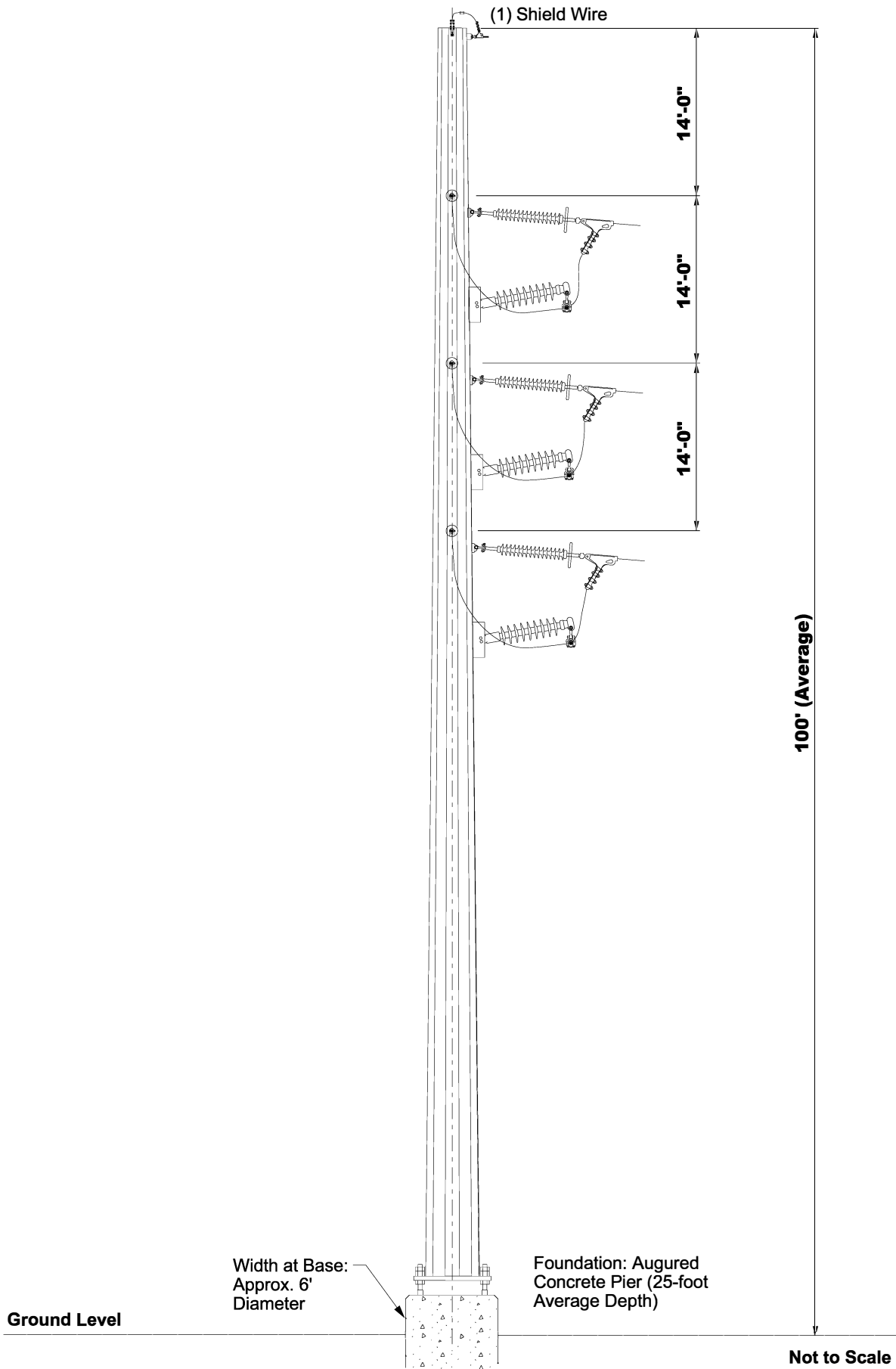

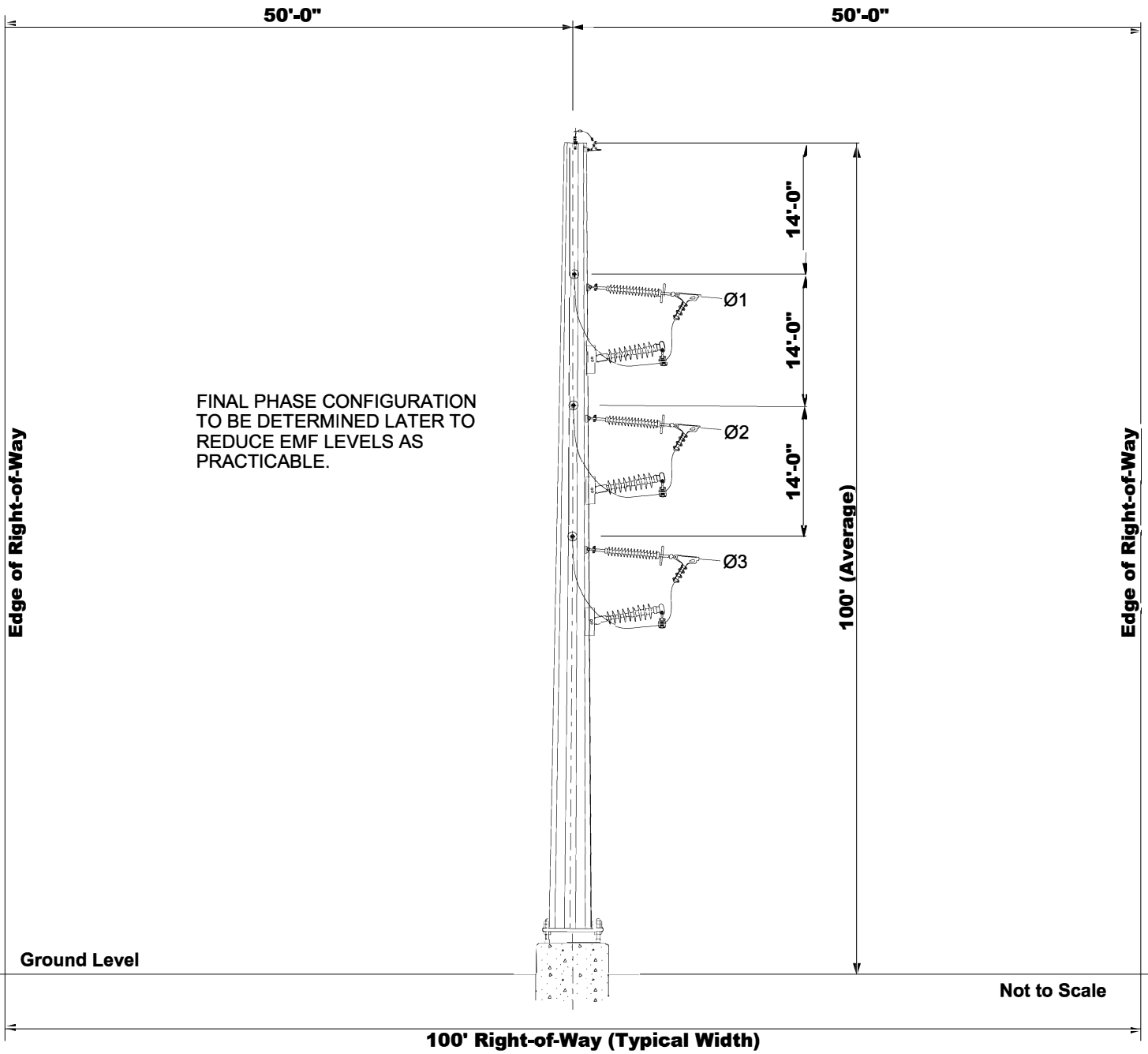
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MONOPOLE FULL DEAD-END (Single Circuit)

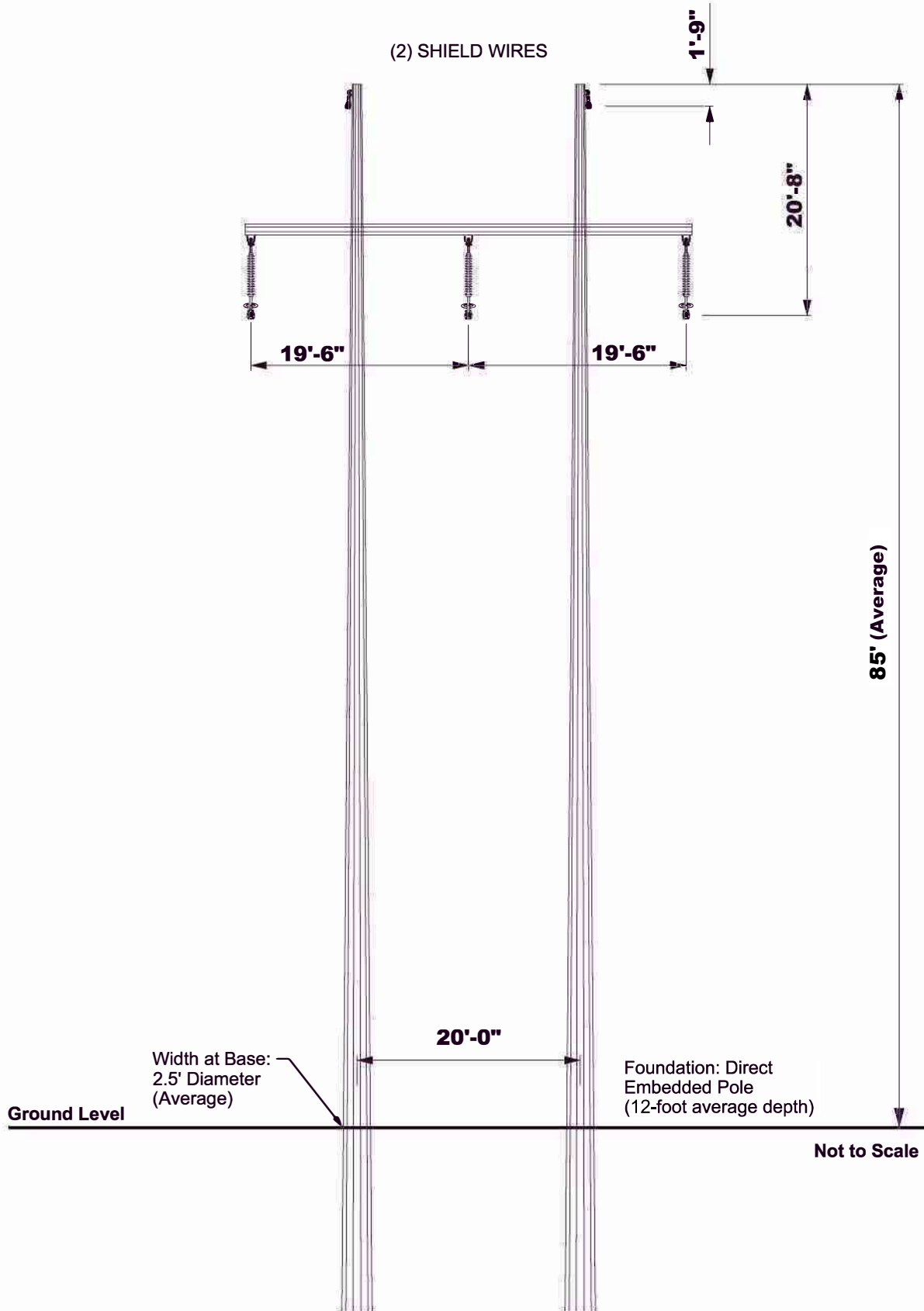

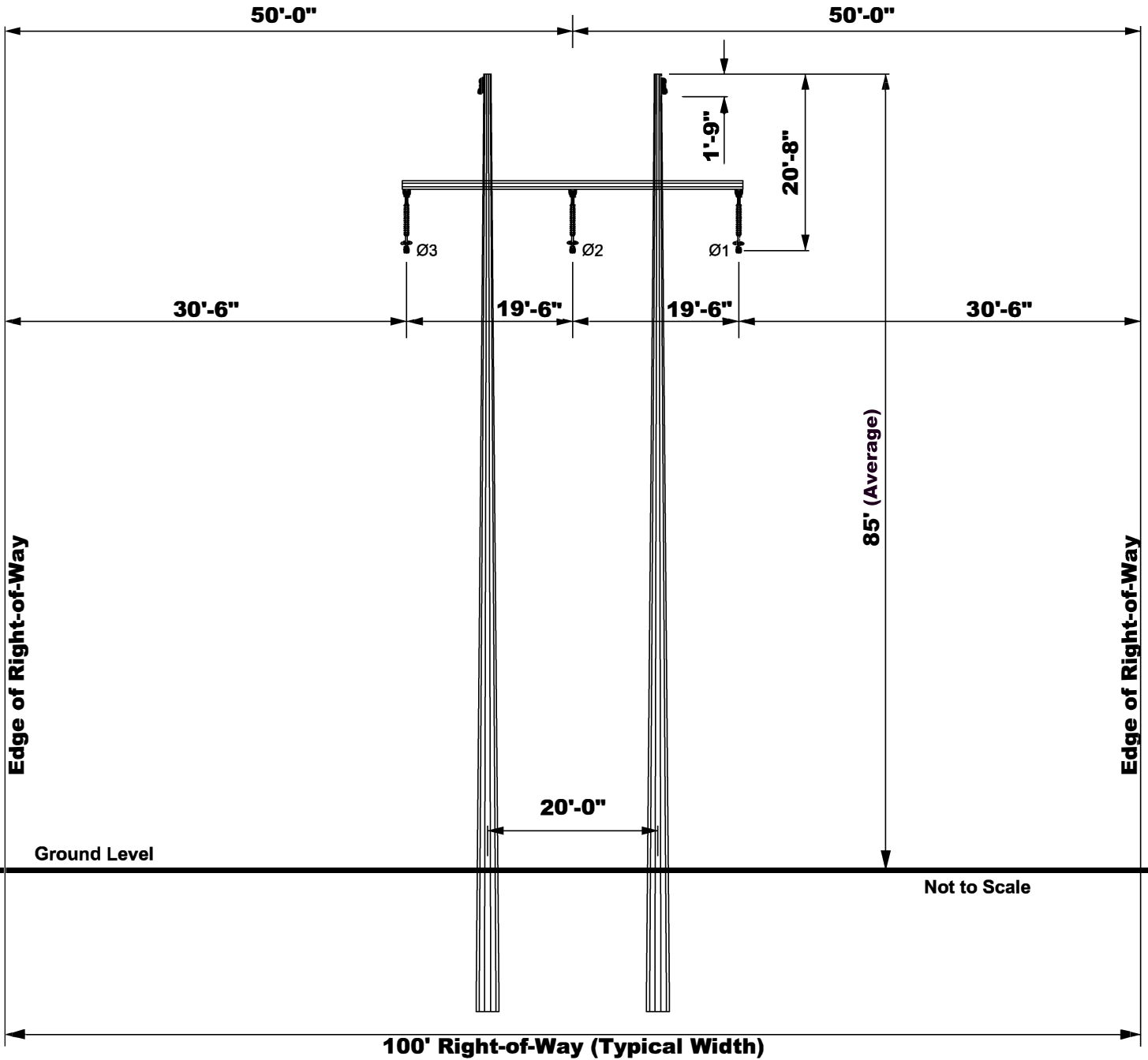
TYPICAL RIGHT-OF-WAY CROSS SECTION

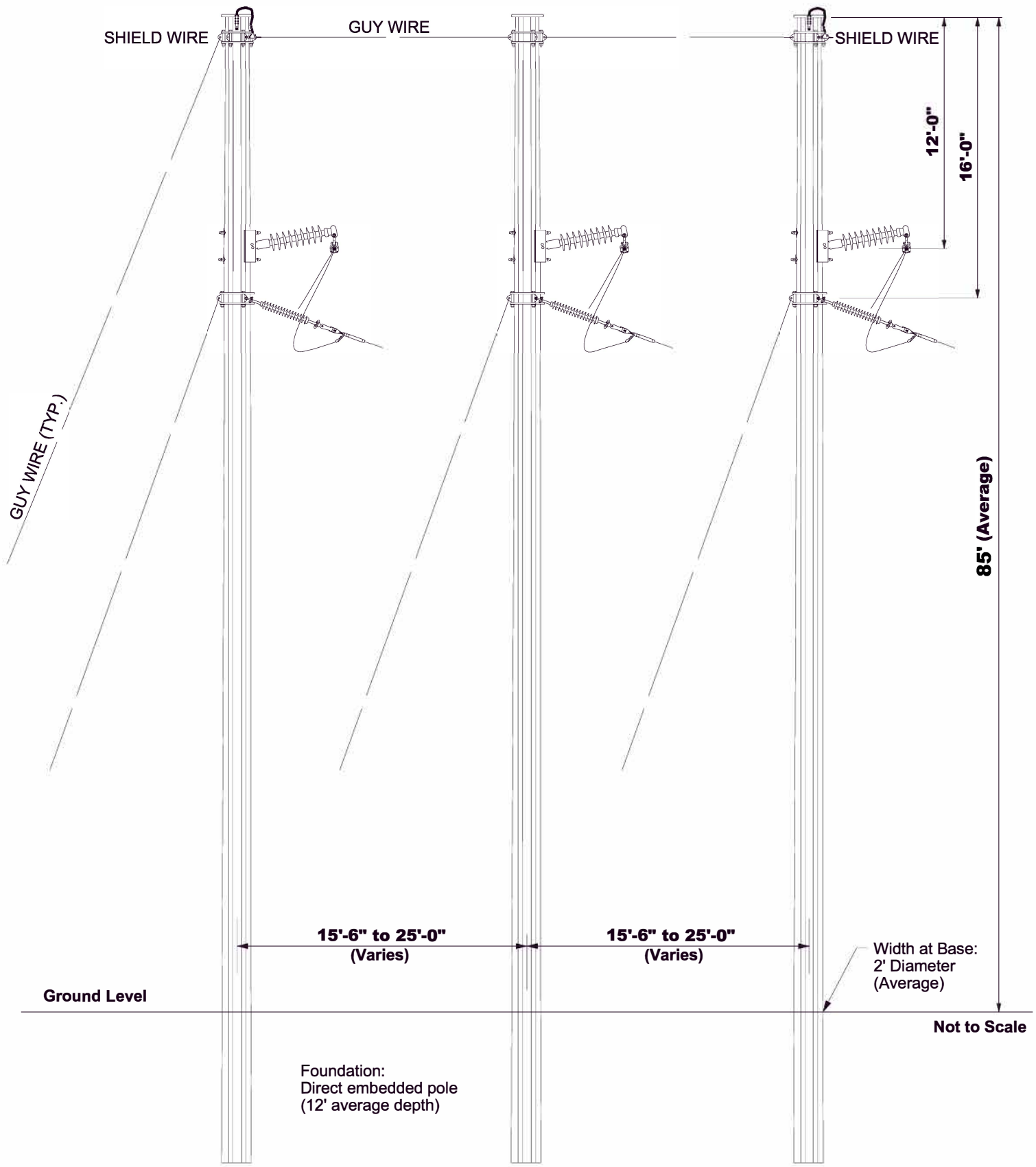


TYPICAL RIGHT-OF-WAY CROSS SECTION

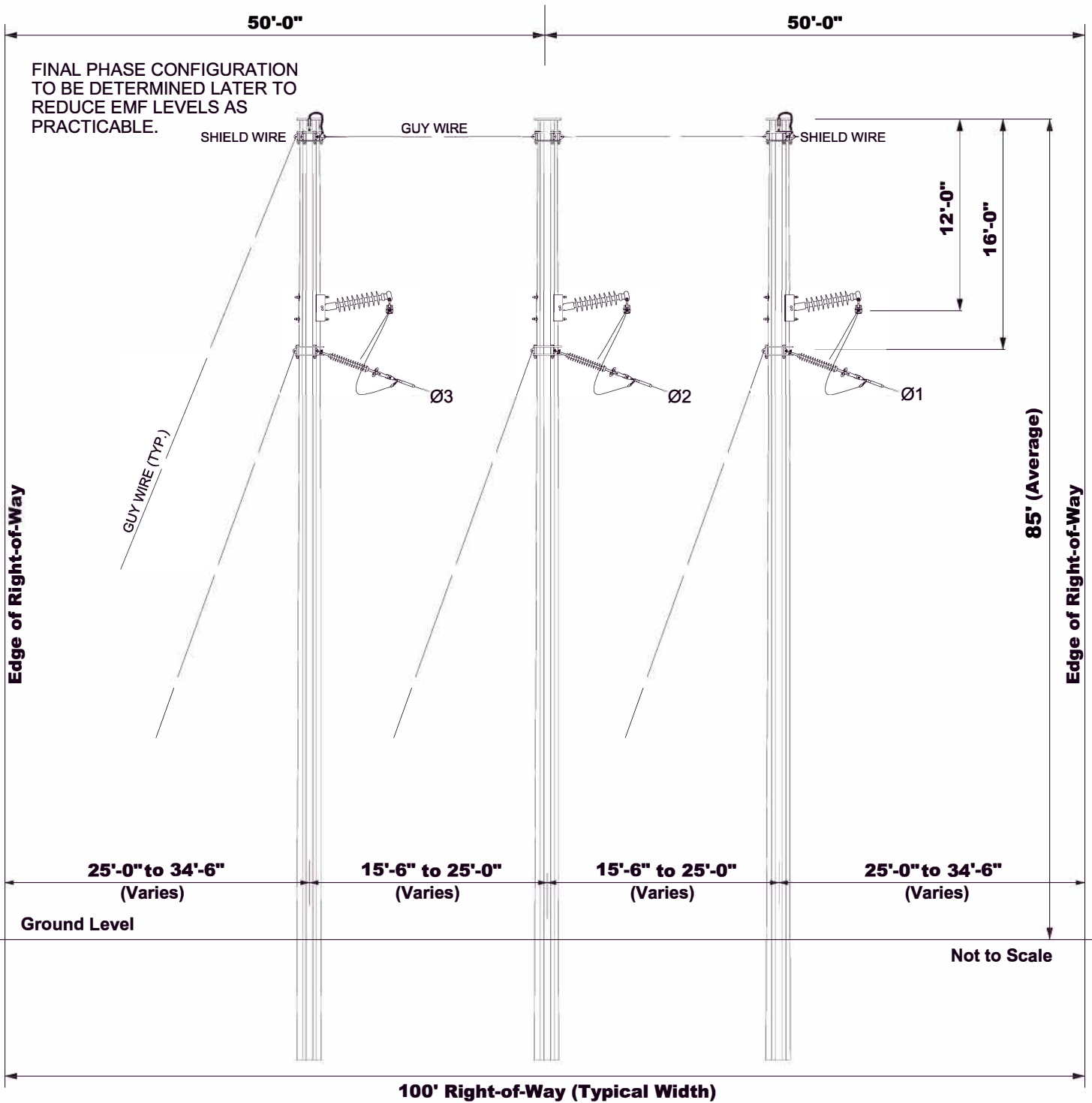


COMPARABLE STRUCTURE PHOTOGRAPH

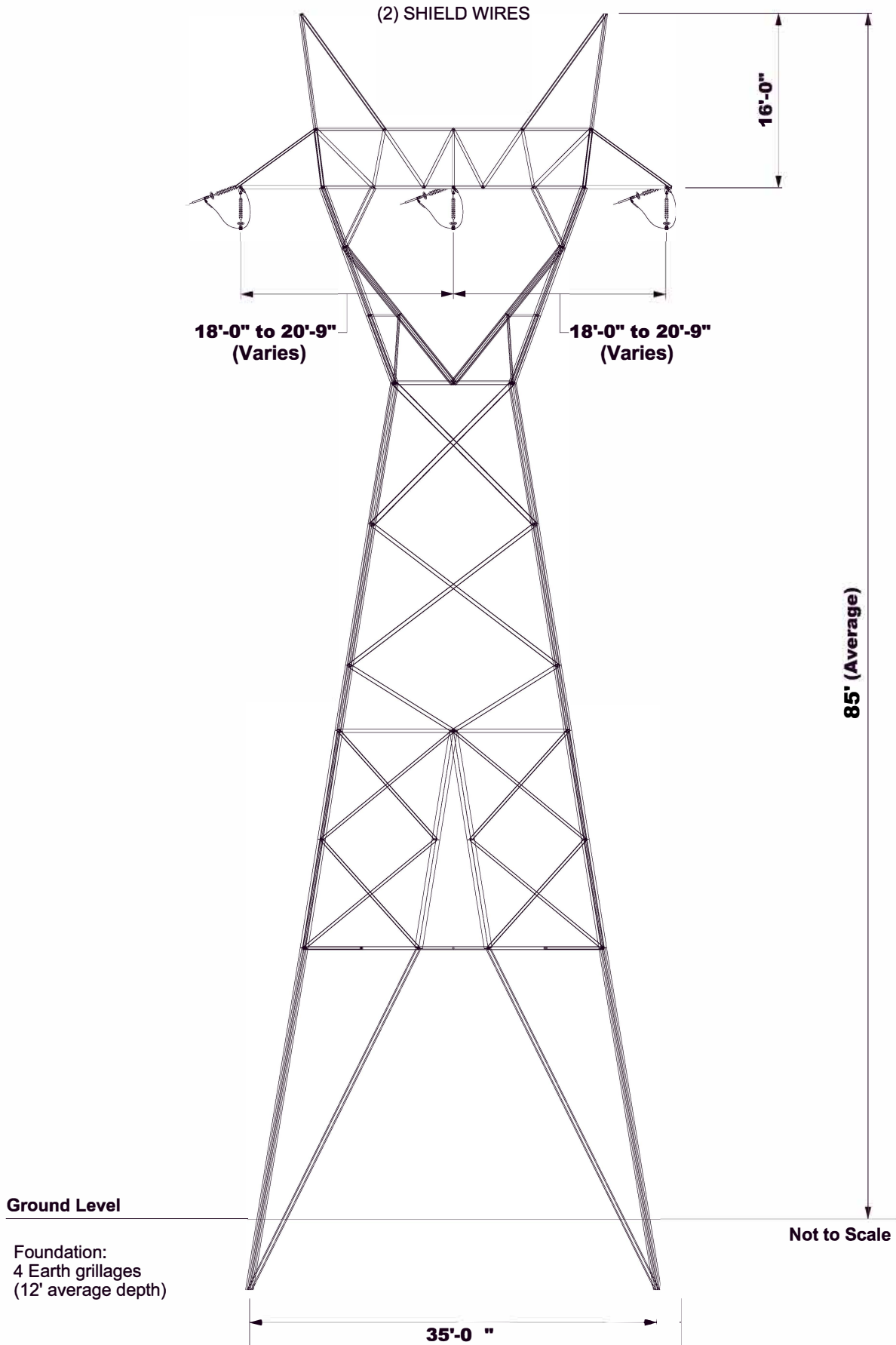


TYPICAL RIGHT-OF-WAY CROSS SECTION

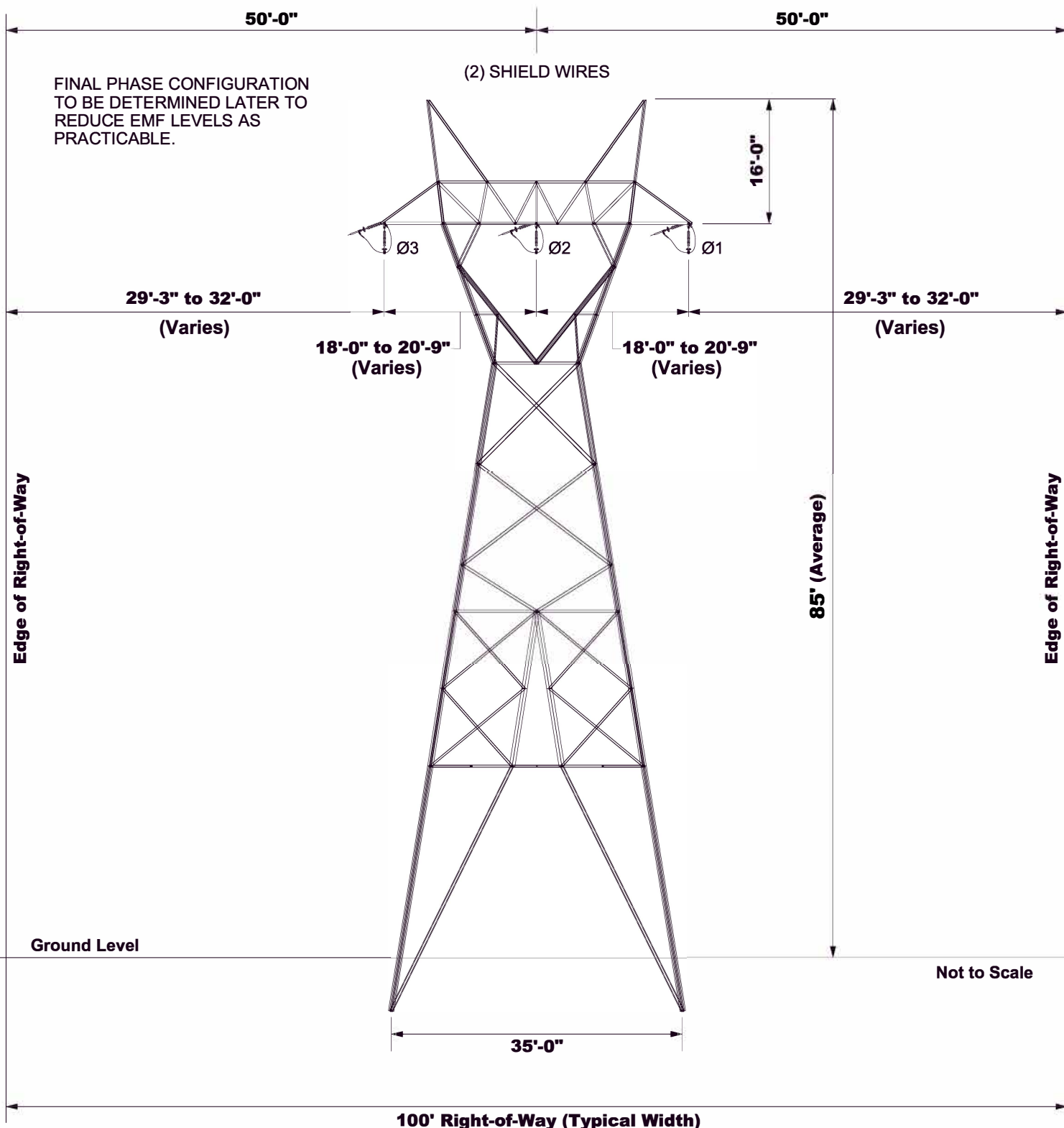

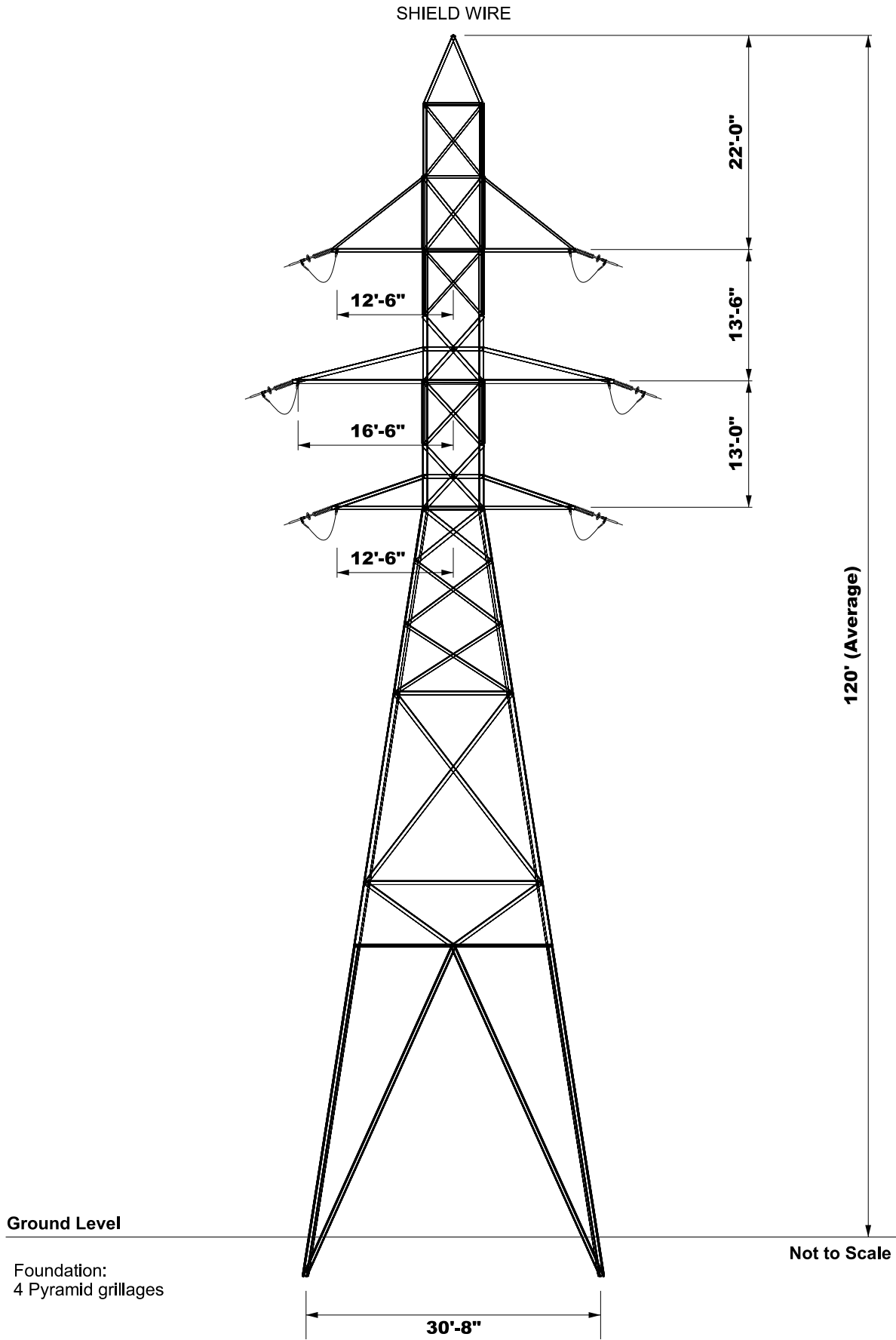


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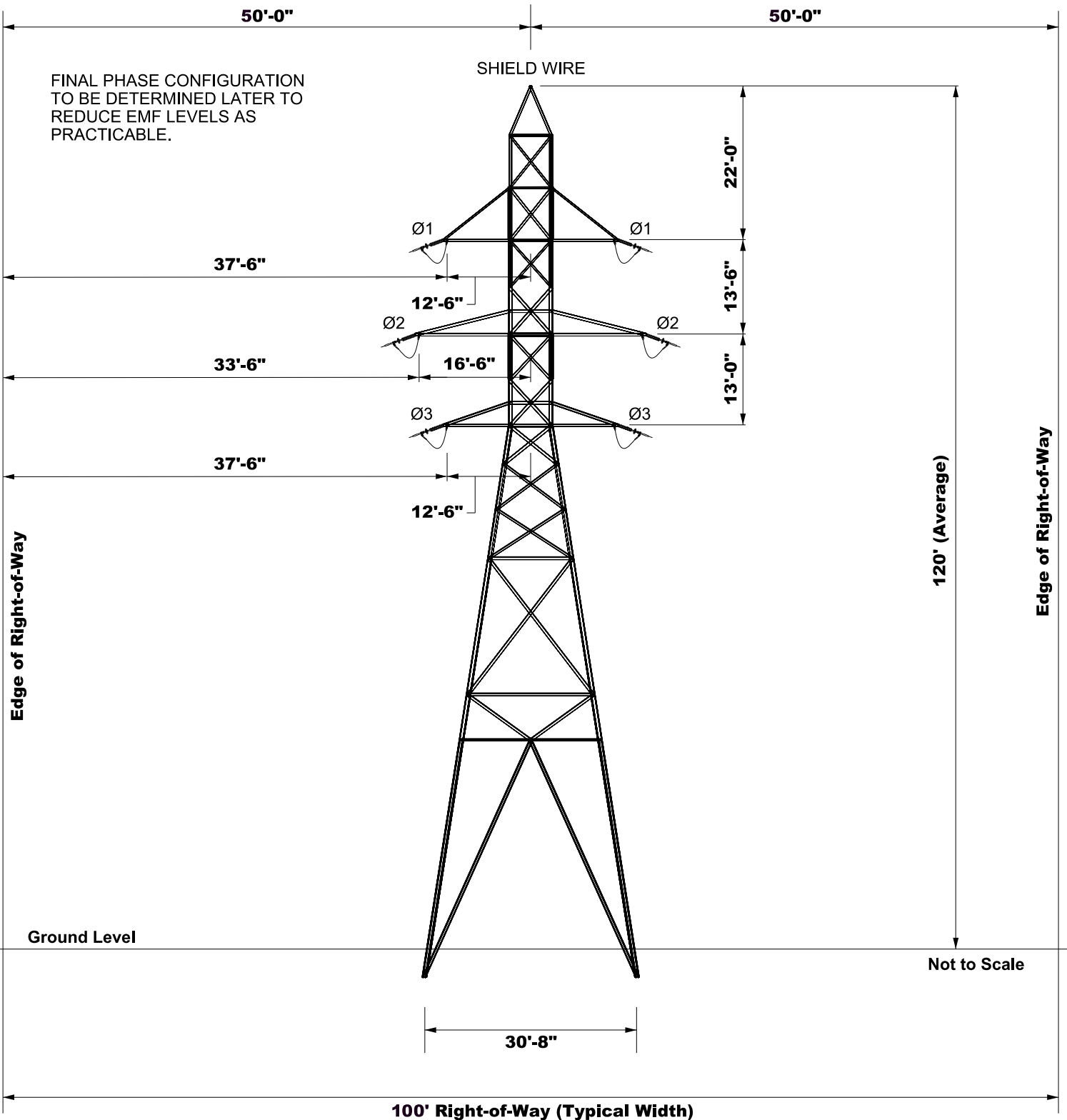
SELF-SUPPORTING LATTICE TOWER (Single Circuit)

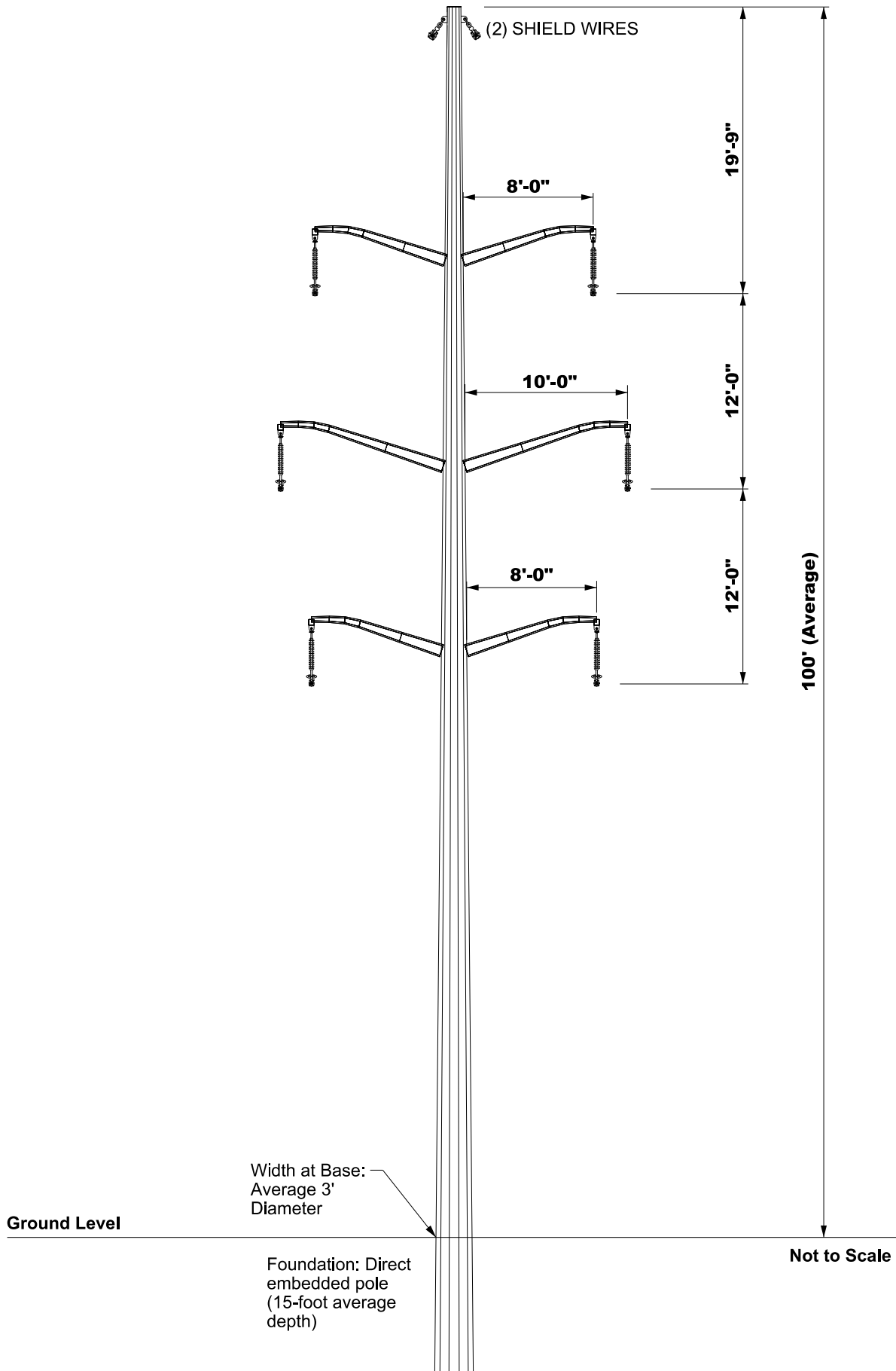


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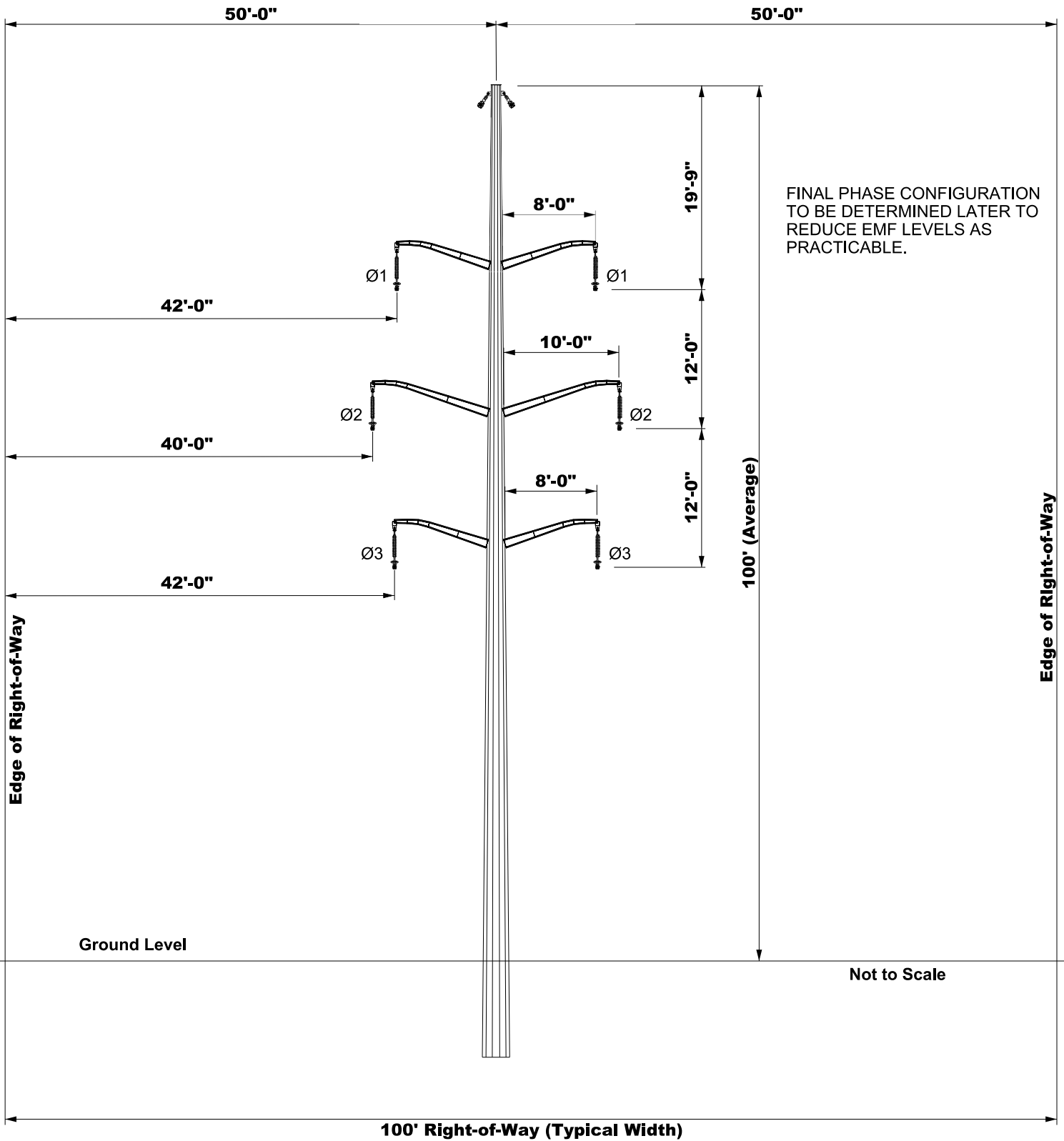


COMPARABLE STRUCTURE PHOTOGRAPH

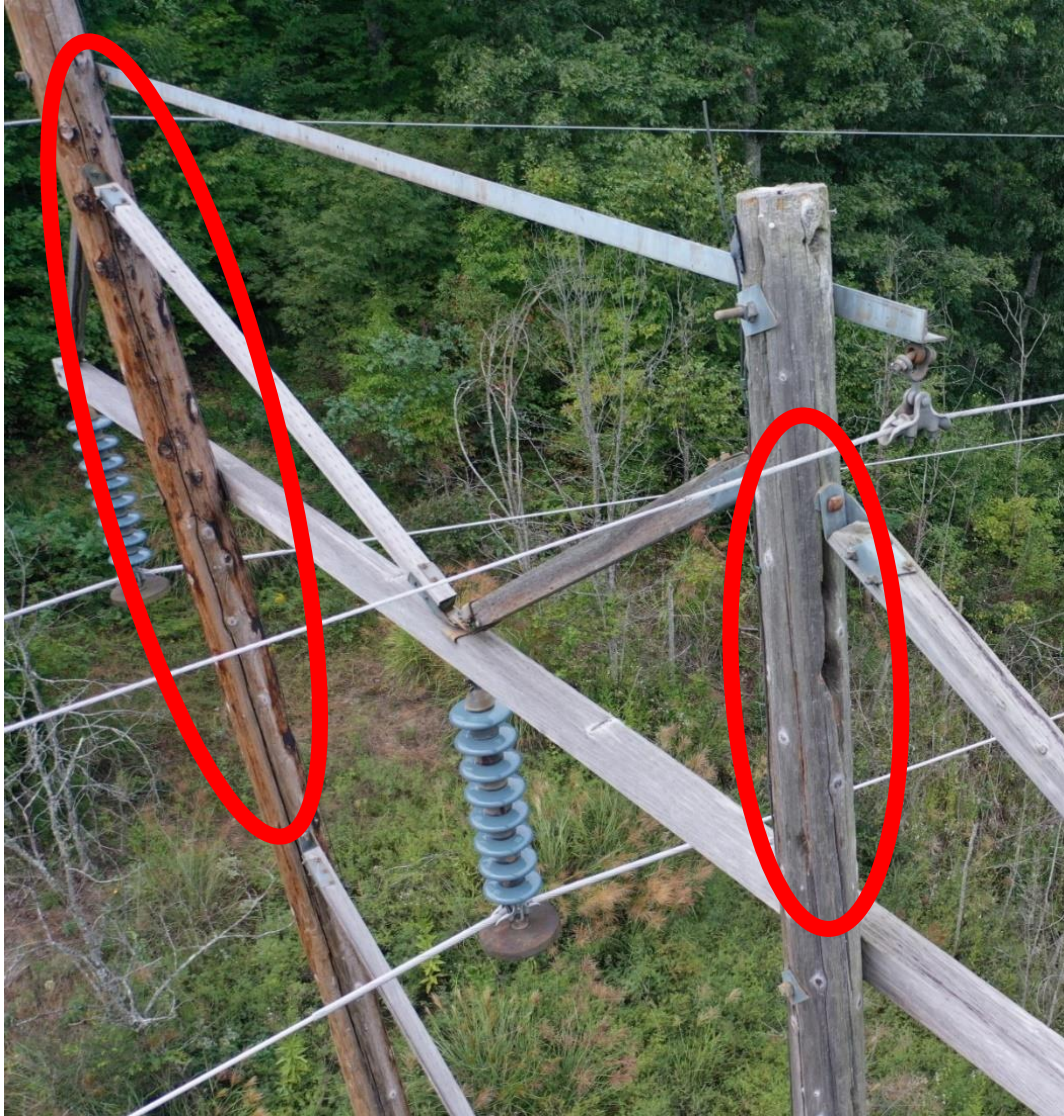

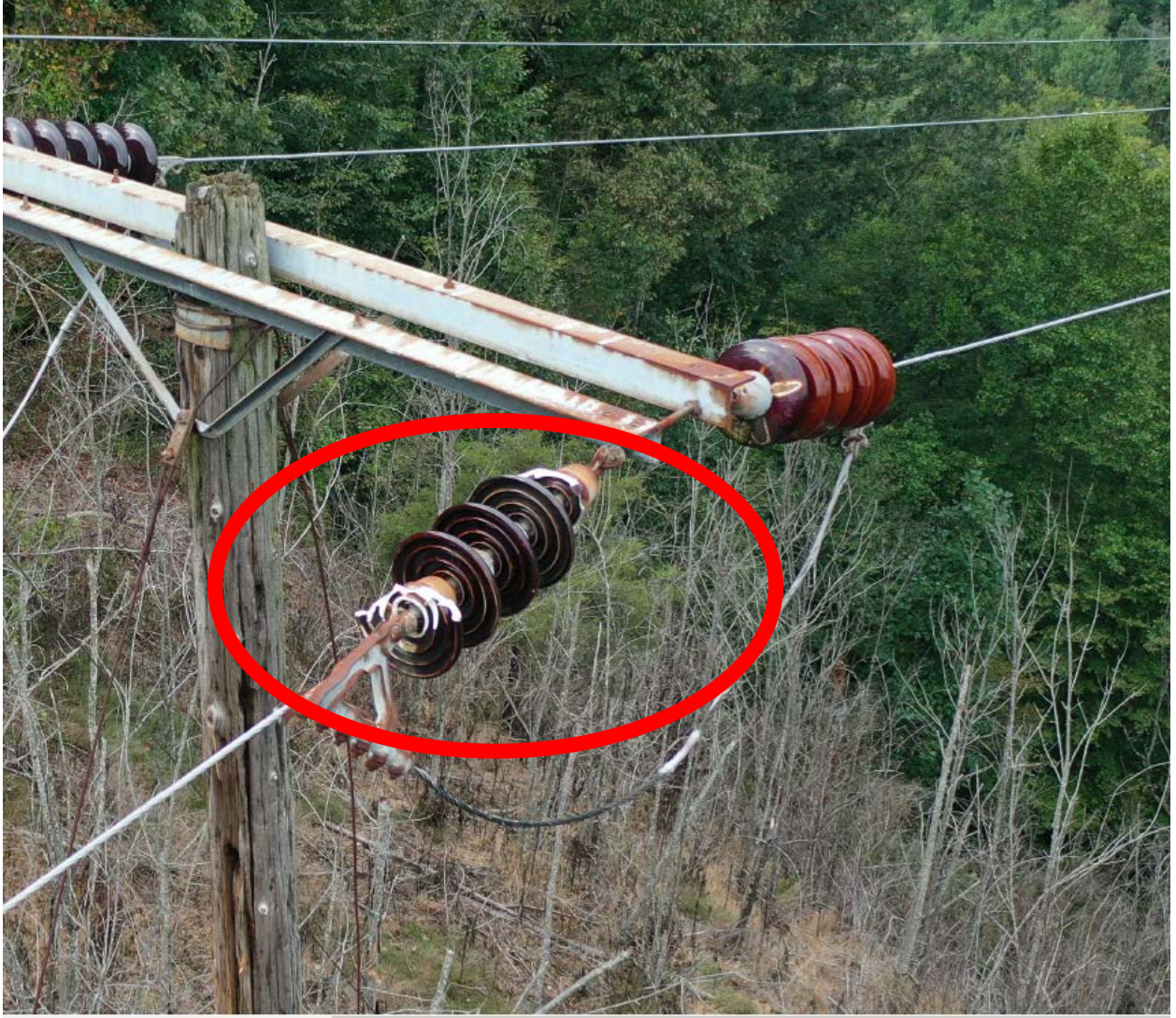

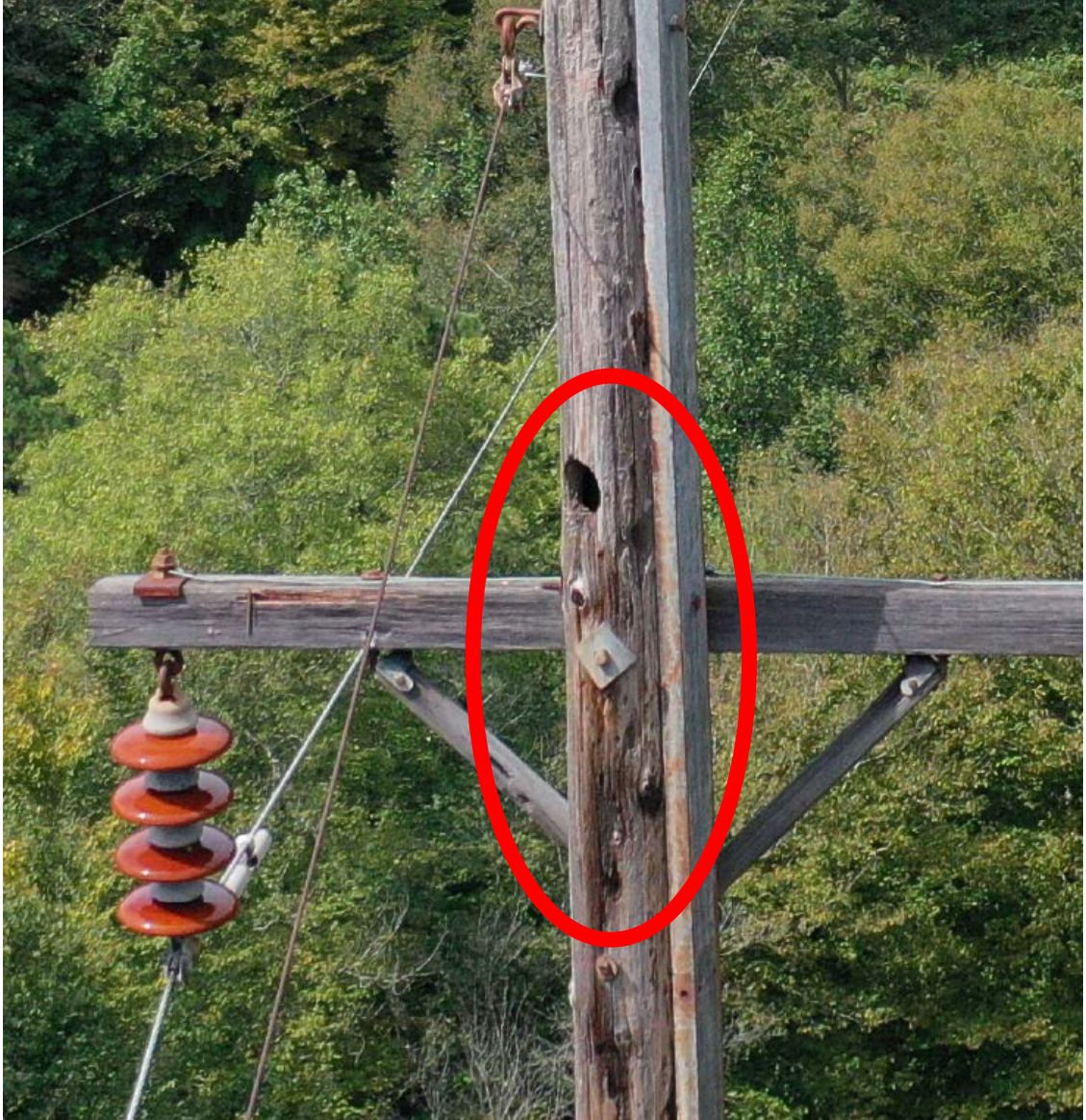

being duly sworn, states as follows:

1. The statements contained in this verification are based upon my personal knowledge, or my review of the records of Kentucky Power Company within the purview of my duties for the Company.
2. The records of the Property Valuation Administrator of Floyd County, Kentucky and the Property Valuation Administrator of Knott County, Kentucky, subject to the corrections and updates described in paragraph 3 below, indicate the filing corridor (including the currently proposed right-of-way) for Kentucky Power Company's Garrett Area Improvements 138 kV Transmission Line will cross the property owned by the persons listed on Exhibit A to this verification.
3. Certain of the addresses obtained from the records of the Property Valuation Administrator of Floyd County, Kentucky and the Property Valuation Administrator of Knott County, Kentucky were determined through earlier mailings or other landowner contact efforts to be incorrect or otherwise undeliverable. Where the Company was able to determine the

correct mailing addresses through landowner communication or other research, Kentucky Power used the updated addresses to ensure the landowners received the required notice

4. On October 25, 2021 the persons on Exhibit A were mailed, or delivered by hand-delivery, the notice required by 807 KAR 5:120, Section 2(3). The form of the notice mailed or hand-delivered is attached to this verification as Exhibit B.

Notice Of Proposed Construction Of Electric Transmission Line

This is to notify you that Kentucky Power Company intends to file with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity in connection with its plans to build the Garrett Area 138-kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line in Knott County and Floyd County, Kentucky. The proposed 138-kV transmission line will be approximately 15 miles. The Garrett Area 138-kV Transmission Line and associated construction described below are known as the “Garrett Area Transmission Line Project” (or the “Project”).

This notice is being provided to you because the records of the Knott County Property Valuation Administrator or the Floyd County Property Valuation Administrator indicate the proposed transmission line may cross property you own.

1. The Project is expected to involve the following work:
 - (a) the construction of approximately 15 miles of new 138-kV transmission line from the vicinity of the Hays Branch 138-kV Substation in Floyd County, Kentucky to the Soft Shell 138-kV Substation in Knott County, Kentucky. Approximately 1.4 miles of the new 138-kV transmission line will be a double circuit line from the new Eastern 138-kV Substation to a new tap structure in the vicinity of existing structure K137-4 on the Hays Branch – Morgan Fork 138-kV transmission line;
 - (b) the construction of the new Eastern 138-kV Substation south of the existing 138 kV Hays Branch Substation in Floyd County, Kentucky;
 - (c) the expansion and conversion of the existing Garrett 46-kV Substation located in Floyd County, Kentucky to a 138-kV Substation;
 - (d) the upgrade of Kentucky Power’s existing Hays Branch 138-kV Substation, McKinney 46-kV McKinney Substation, both of which are in Floyd County, Kentucky, and the Soft Shell 138-kV Substation, which is located in Knott County, Kentucky. Removal work also will be performed at the Beaver Creek 138/69/46 kV Substation located in Floyd County;
 - (e) the performance of work at Kentucky Power’s Snag Fork delivery point at the East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. Salt Lick 138-kV Substation in Floyd County, Kentucky;

(f) the retirement of approximately 25 miles of the 46-kV Beaver Creek – McKinney #1 46-KV circuit, along with the retirement of the Spring Fork Tap and the Shepherd and Lackey Switching Stations; and

(g) the retirement of the Spring Fork 46-kV Transmission Station and the associated 46-kV transmission line. Both are located in Breathitt County, Kentucky.

Kentucky Power also will construct in Breathitt County, Kentucky ordinary extensions of distribution lines in connection with the retirement of the station and transmission line.

2. Enclosed is a map showing the route of the proposed transmission line.

3. The Public Service Commission of Kentucky will process Kentucky Power’s application in Case No. 2021-00346. The address and telephone number of the Executive

Please see 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11) for further information regarding the requirements and procedure for requesting intervention. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11) may be accessed here:

Washington Democrats Vote to Suspend the National Debt Limit & Cut \$1 Billion from Israel's Iron Dome

The U.S. House of Representatives passed a controversial continuing resolution to fund the government through December 3, 2021, on a divided, party-line vote. Washington Democrats used the stop-gap funding bill to suspend the national debt ceiling and to remove \$1 billion in federal support from Israel's air defense system, known as the Iron Dome. Congressman Rogers voted against the legislation.

They are effectively removing the voice of the American people with their exclusive politics."

On Tuesday morning, while simultaneously working to increase spending in the U.S., Democrat leaders announced their decision to block \$1 billion from federal support for Israel's Iron Dome.

"A vote for this legislation is

a devastating vote against Israel, one of our strongest allied nations. Rejecting U.S. funding for Israel, opens the door to new threats against Israel and innocent civilians," said Congressman Rogers, Kentucky's longest-serving Member of Congress and long-time supporter of Israel. "This vote marks a dark day in our historic relationship with Israel. We have stood shoulder-to-shoulder with Israel in bipartisan manner for generations, and we must not bow to the liberal extremists who attempt to demolish our long-held successful partnership."

The legislation now moves to the Democrat-controlled U.S. Senate for consideration before the fiscal year ends on September 30, 2021.

The facility, which is five times larger than Rajant's current building, will expand production and services, including artificial intelligence (AI), and improving its commercial and military products.

Rajant Corporation is raising the bar for innovative, high-tech job opportunities in Eastern Kentucky's partnership with Morehead State University, the premier Science students with NASA, and the widespread opportunities available through the communication and aerospace industries. The west coast has the iconic Silicon Valley, and we are building what I like to call 'Silicon Hill' in Eastern Kentucky," said Congressman Rogers. "I believe in the historic ingenuity and steady work ethic of our region, and this expansion proves that Rajant does as well."

The celebration took place in an open area of the building

designated as "Rogersville," in recognition of Congressman Rogers' support for funding for Kentucky's Fifth Congressional District in 2015.

"Chairman Rogers has become a great friend to us at Rajant and I am forever grateful for his and the Southeast Kentucky Economic Development Corporation for leading us to Morehead, Kentucky. It is clear that he loves Eastern Kentucky, and we do too. Morehead State University is a real treasure and we are hiring many of their brilliant graduates. Because of their drive, determination and integrity, our partnership is a real success story," said Bob Scheana, Chairman/CEO of Rajant Corporation. "It's my goal to take this facility from 30 people to 100 people over the next few years. We will be looking for folks with all kinds of backgrounds from manufacturing and assembly all the way to artificial intelligence and even genetic research as we branch into new areas. It is part of our expansion here in Kentucky."

Rajant originally launched in response to the tragic events of September 11, 2001, among other things to provide communications for emergency responders during disasters. The technology proved to be beneficial for many applications, in-

cluding military operations and the mining industry, expanding Rajant's reach into 280 mines around the world and 60 countries.

The Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA) reported its preliminary approval of a 15-year incentive agreement with Rajant through the Kentucky Business Investment program. The performance-based agreement can provide up to \$300,000 in tax incentives based on the company's investment of \$2 million and meeting annual targets, including paying an average hourly wage of \$25, including benefits.

KEDFA also approved Rajant for up to \$50,000 in tax incentives through the Kentucky Enterprise Initiative Act (KEIA). KEIA allows approved companies to receive Kentucky sales and use tax on construction costs, building fixtures, equipment used in research and development and electronic processing.

The Southeast Kentucky Economic Development Corporation (SKEDC) also provided \$1.5 million in lending, in partnership with The Citizens Bank of Morehead. Congressman Rogers launched SKEDC in 1986 to help create jobs in Eastern Kentucky.

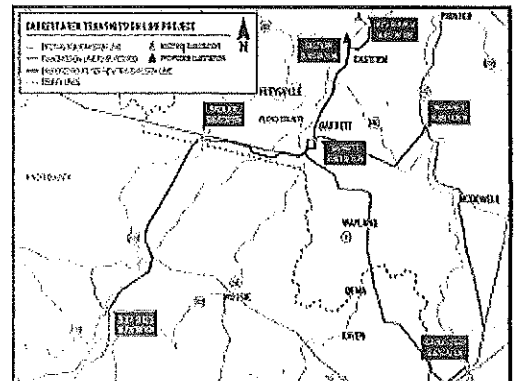

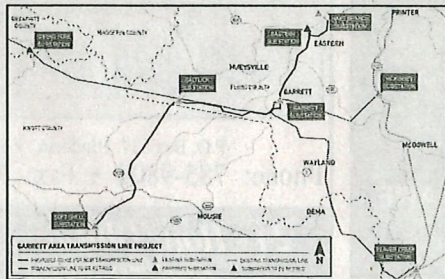

This project will include service for 95 new customers located in numerous areas of Knott County. The project will finish up service to the remaining non-served households in KCWSD's Knott County service area - hence the last mile project. The project will include approximately 43,380 LF of waterline which includes 10,150 LF of 2", 22,930 LF of 3" and 10,300 LF of 4" all proposed as SR-17 PVC waterline. There will be numerous appurtenances included with the project - control valves, flush hydrates, service meters, booster pump station (BPS) and horizontal directional drilling (HDD) with HDPE pipe (3" and 4") bores. The project will also require several railroad bores and CSX RR permit(s) that can possibly require a year or more to obtain. There will be one BPS required to service several homes in the upper headwaters of Deadman Branch.

The Knott County Water and Sewer District has considered the following alternatives and mitigation measures to be taken to minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values: The Knott County Water and Sewer District evaluated alternatives. The first option was to phase the project. This option was not feasible due to the fact it would be cost prohibitive. The second option was to do nothing. This option was not feasible due to the fact it would be leave many customers without water. The third option was to construct project as designed. Part of the project may be in the 100-year floodplain as designated by the September 28, 2007 FEMA Floodplain Maps; with very minimal impacts to the floodplain areas.

The Knott County Water and Sewer has re-evaluated the alternatives to building in the floodplain and has determined that it has no practicable alternative. Environmental files that document compliance with steps 3 through 6 of [Executive Order 11988 and/or 11990], are available for public inspection, review and copying upon request at the times and location delineated in the last paragraph of this notice for receipt of comments. This activity will have no significant impact on the environment for the following reasons:

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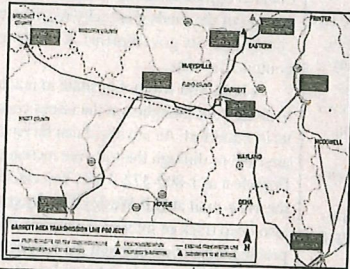
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A map of the proposed route for the line is shown below.

KENTUCKY POWER PLANS POWER GRID IMPROVEMENTS IN FLOYD AND KNOTT COUNTIES

ASHLAND, Ky., March 11, 2021 – Kentucky Power officials plan upgrades to the electric transmission system in Floyd and Knott counties. The Garrett Area Transmission Line Project involves:

- Building approximately 15 miles of 138-kilovolt electric transmission line
- Building the Eastern Substation
- Expanding the Garrett Substation
- Making upgrades to the Hays Branch, Saltlick and Soft Shell substations

Construction of the new line allows crews to retire approximately 25 miles of transmission line that includes deteriorating wooden poles from the 1920s and 1940s. The existing line has experienced multiple power outages in recent years.

“Transmission improvement projects such as the Garrett project represent meaningful investment in eastern Kentucky,” said Brett Mattison, Kentucky Power president and chief operating officer. “This project strengthens the local power grid and helps to ensure reliable electric service for area customers.”

Company representatives are evaluating several route options for the new transmission line. The project begins at the Hays Branch Substation in Floyd County and continues about 1 mile southwest to the proposed Eastern Substation located along Route 80. From there the project continues about 4 miles south toward Garrett Substation west of Route 680. It continues about 4 miles west to Saltlick Substation, an East Kentucky Power Cooperative substation near the Floyd/Knott county line. The project then crosses the county line into Knott County and continues about 6 miles southwest to the Soft Shell Substation northeast of Route 1098.

The Kentucky Power project team invites landowners in the project area to visit **KentuckyPower.com/Garrett** to learn more about the project, enter a virtual open house and provide feedback by Monday, April 19. The online open house complies with physical distancing recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention during COVID-19.

Area landowners can expect to receive a packet in the mail that includes additional project details and a comment card they can return with their feedback. The packet also includes an invitation to two live virtual town hall events on April 1 that landowners can join online or by phone to learn more about the project, ask questions and share input.

The project team plans to use feedback from the virtual open house, comment cards, virtual town hall events and additional field work to determine a power line route that minimizes impact to the community and environment.
