**JACKSON PURCHASE ENERGY CORPORATION’S RESPONSE
TO REHEARING REQUEST OF ATTORNEY GENERAL**

Comes now Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“Jackson Purchase” or “Cooperative”), by counsel, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(2), and files its Response to the Rehearing Request of the Kentucky Attorney General (“AG”) filed on April 13, 2022. The AG’s Rehearing Request seeks to correct a mathematical error made in the Commission’s revenue requirement adjustment related to Salaries and Wage Expense. The AG asserts that due to this mathematical error the revenue requirement contained in the Commission’s Final Order of April 8, 2022 is overstated by \$52,391.

Jackson Purchase has performed the same calculation as described in the AG’s Rehearing Request and agrees with the AG that the revenue requirement is overstated by \$52,391. Following confirmation of this calculation counsel for Jackson Purchase advised counsel for the AG of Jackson Purchase’s agreement to the Rehearing Request on this point.

Wherefore, Jackson Purchase has no objection to the AG’s Rehearing Request and agrees to the entry of a Commission order correcting this error.
