 - **a.** Please confirm that the location of Kenergy's proposed fiberoptic facilities will not be limited to the areas that Kenergy believes to be unserved or underserved set forth in the maps accompanying its response to KBCA's Data Request No. 1.
 - **b.** Please confirm that the locations of Kenergy's proposed fiberoptic facilities are represented by the maps provided in its response to KBCA's Data Request No. 5.
 - c. Please confirm that Kenergy's proposed lease and sublease of its proposed fiberoptic facilities will not be limited to areas identified as unserved or underserved in the maps accompanying its response to KBCA's Data Request No. 1.
 - d. Please confirm that Kenergy's proposed lease of its proposed fiberoptic facilities will be for the proposed fiberoptic system in its entirety, as identified in the maps provided in its response to KBCA Data Request No. 5.
 - e. Please confirm whether Kenergy's proposed sublease of its proposed fiberoptic facilities will be for the proposed fiberoptic system in its entirety, as identified in the maps provided in its response to KBCA Data

Request No. 5. If not, please identify the area covered by the proposed sublease.

- **f.** Please confirm that the terms of Kenergy's proposed lease of its proposed fiberoptic facilities will not prohibit Kenect from using the system to offer broadband services outside of the areas identified by Kenergy as unserved or underserved.
- **g.** Please confirm that the terms of Kenergy's proposed sublease of its proposed fiberoptic facilities will not prohibit Conexon Connect from using the system to offer broadband services outside of the areas identified by Kenergy as unserved or underserved.
- **12.** Please identify which steps, if any, Kenergy and/or Kenect intend to take to ensure that the proposed fiberoptic facilities are used to offer broadband services only in areas identified as unserved or underserved.
