**SIERRA CLUB’S MOTION TO PARTICIPATE VIRTUALLY
IN NOVEMBER 30, 2021, HEARING**

Pursuant to the Commission’s October 28, 2021, Order in the above-captioned case, Sierra Club respectfully moves the Commission to permit the undersigned counsel to attend the November 30, 2021, hearing virtually, in light of risks and restrictions associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. Sierra Club will not be presenting any witnesses at the hearing. In support of this Motion, Sierra Club states that its current policy prohibits work-related travel by staff, with exceptions considered on a case-by-case basis only for extraordinary essential situations; that counsel is a caregiver to a family member who is at heightened risk; and that the ongoing rise in cases during the propagation of the Delta variant causes added concern. Sierra Club further submits that its virtual attendance will not prejudice the Commission or any party. Counsel for Sierra Club has participated virtually in several Commission hearings without issue during the pandemic, and their virtual attendance at this hearing would likewise go smoothly. Sierra Club thanks the Commission for its consideration of this Motion.
